

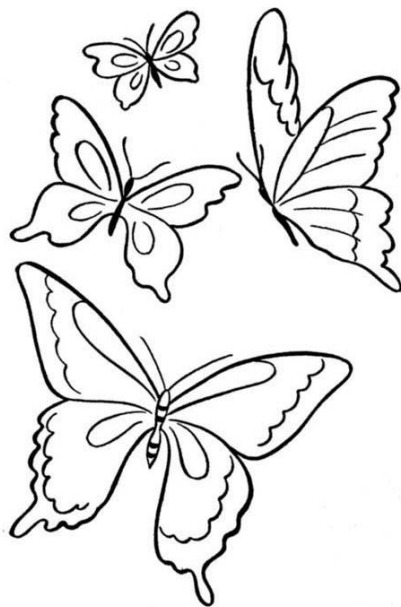
7 Spirits of God and Evangelism

Chapter 1: Come Up Higher

He is calling us to worship, walk and minister as our Lord Jesus Christ did.

Our Lord ministered out of the fullness

Joh 1:16 And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

He had the Spirit of the Lord God upon Him and within Him as He walked in deep intimate fellowship with Abba Father.

As we go deeper into this intimate fellowship, surrender more and more to the work of the cross of Christ, and believe, then we can enter the fullness.

As the End Time believers grow up into the stature of Christ, they will be used to walk in the glorious End Time outpouring of holy glory and its signs, wonders and miracles for the salvation of the lost souls.

For the Earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of God.

Hab 2:14 For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

The understanding of and the ministry in the fullness of the 7 Spirits of God being activated in our lives is the key to seeing God's End Time mandate being fulfilled in the Last Days.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

7 Rivers

I love to walk and pray in nature.

I will go on prayer walks in the forest, on hills, by the ocean, and in other places.

It helps to walk and pray to still the soul so we can hear the voice of God in our spirit more easily.

In the year 2000, I was praying in the forest, and the Lord's voice came to me.

He said, Nicholas, there are 7 rivers.

I did not understand what the Lord was trying to teach me at that time.

So, the Lord put me on a journey.

A journey to learn about the 7 rivers or 7 Spirits of God.

Our Lord Jesus Christ said that rivers would flow out of our innermost beings.

Joh 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

7 is the number of fullness and God is calling us to see these rivers, in fullness, flow out of us.

Brian Gurion's Vision

Brian had a vision on the day of celebration for the 100 years since the first Pentecost.

He saw William Seymour, who was used in the Azusa street revival in the vision.

William used to put his head under a shoebox when he was praying at the revival meetings when the glory of God was falling.

In the vision, a voice said that William was used to seeing the fullness come down in the meetings, yet they didn't stay in the fullness.

The Holy Spirit also said that in the End Time, the bride of Christ would learn to walk in the fullness or 7 Spirits of God and would finish the race set before them in the fullness.

God's Holy Glory Fire in Burma

In 2010, I was invited to minister in Burma.

I was first teaching at a Bible school where many young people were being trained.

I had a picture of the real Mt Sinai with me.

The real Mt Sinai is in Arabia, not in the Egyptian Peninsula.

Gal 4:25 For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children.

Scripture shows it is in Arabia and the rocks on the top of the mountain are black.

Why are those rocks black?

This is so because the holy fiery presence of God made the mountain melt.

Psa 97:5 The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.

Our God is holy and a consuming fire.

When I showed them the picture and the scriptures about it, the Holy Spirit fell on the students.

Transformation

Students began to weep in repentance.

Then they were being transformed by the move of God.

When the fullness of God started to move, revelation and visions started to come because of the Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

Eph 1:17-18 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: (18) The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

The Spirit of wisdom and revelation are 2 of the 7 Spirits of God which were activated there among the bible school students.

God the Father's holy presence started to invade their hearts, for this was revealed to them by the scriptures and the Holy Spirit.

The love of Father God was released and started to heal broken hearts.

The Cross of Christ

Apostle Paul says that he preached nothing but the cross of Christ.

He said this so that our faith would be built upon God's power and the work of the Holy Spirit

1Co 2:2-5 For I determined not to know anything among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified. (3) And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. (4) And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: (5) That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

To grow in the fullness is to grow in surrender and brokenness of me, myself, and I at the cross of Christ.

Out of it, we are to learn to abide in the presence of God's Spirit in and upon our lives.

Christ showed us a life of selflessness and living in the fullness of God.

As we, as the true body of Christ, pick up our cross, surrender, and are on fire, a multitude of souls that no one can count on will come to Christ as we evangelise in these Last Days.

Revival at the Baptist Church

There was persecution when I went to Burma, so I could not take a Bible, but Pastor Paul would have a Bible for me.

There were spies around me.

Pastor Paul had been beaten by these police for being a Christian.

They had experienced a revival in this church and this time, God would lift them higher in the things of the kingdom of God.

The second night, the glory cloud came into the meeting, lifting believers into the realm of holy glory.

The fire of the holy presence of God would make them weep and bring deeper cleansing and purity.

The true ministry of the cross of Christ brings brokenness and the holy fire of the Holy Spirit, demonstrating the power of the Holy Spirit.

1Co 2:2,5 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified. (5) That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

People were weeping for hours in the holy presence of God as we sang, "I surrender all".

Testimonies

For 7 days, we stayed ministering in this place as God's glory cloud stayed there.

I cancelled other meetings so we could be in one place.

Every day, many testimonies were given.

Some people were in other towns and God showed them the move in this place by vision, so they came.

There were testimonies of healings and miracles as they were on their knees worshipping the Lord. Others had encountered heaven; others had seen angels as was told when they gave their testimonies.

Now I understand here that the fullness of the Spirit of the Lord was moving in this place.

Believers were entering into the move of the 7 Spirits of the Lord, which is the fullness.

Into India

Pastor Paul was also an evangelist.

He went just over the border into India's state Mizoram when I left.

God moved in a mighty way, people were saved, healed, and set free.

He called me and said that the move of the 7 Spirits of God or fullness, that he had received as I had ministered in his church and to him, now moved through his ministry in India.

He said that the pastors there had asked if I could please come and minister to them also. All glory to God, Amen.

Last Day Ministry

I shared these stories to show you what God has in store for us in these Last Days.

I knew then that what I experienced in Burma was a forerunner experience of the Last Days ministry.

They were in persecution, and I experienced some of it then.

It takes faith, perseverance, brokenness, and mighty power to move in a place like that.

Today, we are in troubled times because of the Covid 19.

This is a time to be a light.

God is calling us to come up higher so we can learn to minister in the fullness.

We must learn how to come up higher and how to let the fullness overtake us as we open for the 7 Spirits of God in our lives.

They will cause us to have a more intimate relationship with the Godhead, also more productive and powerful in the operation of the Holy Spirit.

A Vision in 2004

In 2004, I received a vision.

In the vision, the Lord showed me 7 levels.

Many believers are living in the lower levels.

God is calling us up higher, so our lives and ministry will be in the higher levels from where Jesus Christ also lived and ministered from.

The 7 Levels

1. Holy Realm

Rev 4:8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him, and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.



(Out of here flows the fullness down)



2. Fullness or the realm of the Seven Spirits of God

Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.



3. The glory realm

Heb 2:10 For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.



4. In the anointing

Isa 10:27 And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.



5. In the blessing of God

Deu 28:2 And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.



6. In Christian traditions

Mar 7:3 For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash *their* hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders. Mar 7:9 And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.



7. In a cold or dead traditional church.

Rev 3:1 And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

The Level of Fullness and the 7 Spirits

God is holy and glorious; He is one God who comes to us through the Holy Spirit whereby He manifests in 7 ways.

We call this the fullness or the 7 Spirits of God.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Today, God is calling us to learn about the 7 Spirits of God so we can live, function and minister out of the fullness.

Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

In Greek, glory is *Doxa*, which means all that God is and all that He has.

The first 3 levels show us who God is (Levels 1, 2 and 3).

Then the next 2 levels are what He gives (Levels 4 and 5)

The 7-Armed Candlestick



Today the true symbol of Israel is the 7-armed candlestick they call the Menorah.

God told Moses to make the 7-armed candlestick and it had to be placed in the holy place of the tabernacle.

On the other side of the veil was the Ark of the Covenant.

Today, the veil is gone.

2Co 3:16 Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away.

The symbol of the 7-armed candlestick before the Ark is a prophetic picture.

It is the representation of the 7 Spirits of God before the throne of God.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Today, we are called to enter these dimensions of the Spirit of the Lord which is one of the 7 Spirits of God to be worshipping before the throne of God.

This is so we are changed from glory to glory.

2Co 3:17-18 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. (18) But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

As we enter these realms of the 7 Spirits of God in worship before the throne of God, we learn to enter into the fullness of God.

As we do this, we will be rooted and grounded more deeply in the love of Christ and the love of God.

Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

The 7 Spirits of God

The 7-armed candlestick is a symbol of the 7 Spirits of God.

The 7-armed candlestick is a prophetic picture of the 7 Spirits of God.

Therefore, let us now look at the 7 Spirits of God before the throne.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

We are going to name these 7 Spirits and the first place they are named is by the prophet Isaiah.

Isa 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

The Names of the 7 Spirits of God:

1. Spirit of the Lord
2. Spirit of wisdom
3. Spirit of understanding or revelation
4. Spirit of counsel
5. Spirit of might
6. Spirit of knowledge
7. Spirit of the fear of the Lord

Short Explanation of the 7 Spirits of God

In this school, we will deal more clearly with the 7 Spirits of God and evangelism.

Now we will give you a little understanding of them.

1. Spirit of the Lord

The Spirit of the Lord God is the main Spirit of the fullness were through the rest of the 7 Spirits function.

It is the Father of glory who flows through this Spirit to give us wisdom and revelation.

Eph 1:17-18 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: (18) The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

2. Spirit of Wisdom

The Spirit of wisdom is the release of understanding and knowledge in what to do in every situation.

3. Spirit of Understanding or Revelation

The Spirit of revelation reveals the deep secrets of God, so we may know Him more intimately.

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

4. Spirit of Counsel

The Spirit of counsel shows us what to do and how to minister with the power or might of God as we do evangelism or ministry.

5. Spirit of Might

This is the Spirit that releases God's power in action, it enables us to do signs, wonders and miracles.

6. Spirit of Knowledge

The Spirit of knowledge makes things known to us and leads us into a deeper intimate fellowship with God.

7. Spirit of the fear of the Lord

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord convicts sinners of their sins.

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord also gives evangelists and preachers the anointing whereby sinners are convicted of their sin.

William Branham

When William was baptised in the Ohio River, a fireball came down and entered him.

William learnt to minister in the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

When the Spirit of the Lord would move upon him, he knew people's names, problems and sicknesses.

Then the delivering and healing power came, and miracles would happen.

Many were saved, healed and set free in his revival tent meetings.

There was Power to Heal

Our Lord Jesus Christ evangelist and ministered out of the glory, the fullness, which is the 7 Spirits of God in operation.

Joh 1:16 And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

When Jesus was evangelising, preaching, ministering and healing, the scripture says that there was power to heal.

Jesus Christ did the miracles out of the mighty power of the Spirit of might.

Luk 5:17 And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was present to heal them.

It says that the power of the Lord was present.

The main spirit of the 7 is the Spirit of the Lord and it released the mighty power of God to be present to heal there in Galilea.

Therefore, there was an open heaven in that place.

When Jesus saw the faith of the 4 men that let the paralysed man through the roof, He ministered to this man.

He said, stand up for your sins are forgiven.

Luk 5:17-20 And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was present to heal them. (18) And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought means to bring him in, and to lay him before him. (19) And when they could not find by what way they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with his couch into the midst before Jesus. (20) And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee.

The man stood up and was healed.

Luk 5:25 And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.

It was a sign to all that Jesus Christ is the Saviour and Lord.

Now people could believe and come to Christ.

Chapter 2: The Spirit of the Lord and Healing

Encounter

Once, I had a heavenly realm encounter.

It was an encounter with the Spirit of the Lord.

The beautiful thing about it was that in encountering the Spirit of the Lord God, I encountered the Father heart of God.

The Father heart of God comes to us through the Spirit of the Lord God.

Therefore, the Spirit of the Lord reveals to us the heart of God as the Spirit of the revelation is also flowing.

Manifestation of the Father Heart

The manifestation of the Father heart of God comes powerfully to us through the Spirit of the Lord God.

As the manifestation of the Father heart of God is in action, healing and deliverance take place.

Isa 61:1-2 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; (2) To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

When I was baptised with the Holy Spirit and fire, I cried a lot as the love of God was poured out upon me by the Holy Spirit.

Now, as I encounter more of the Spirit of the Lord God, this healing and the freedom that the Spirit of the Lord is bringing in my life is increasing.

2Co 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

Changed from Glory to Glory

- ❖ The Spirit of the Lord God wants to change us and make us free of ourselves and our old ways.
- ❖ The fullness, which is the 7 Spirits burning, wants to change us from glory to glory.
- ❖ This happens because the Spirit of the Lord is also full of glory and manifests the glory.
- ❖ The glory of God is the manifest presence of God.
- ❖ The Spirit of the Lord, yes, the 7 Spirits of God, manifest and demonstrate the power and glory of God on earth.

- ❖ If we want to be used powerfully in evangelism and ministry, we need to open up and be hungry for the 7 Spirits of God.

The Father of Glory

On earth, the Father of glory comes to us by the Spirit of the Lord God.

The Father heart of God will be revealed to us through the Spirit of revelation.

This is why Apostle Paul said that he prayed for the believers in Ephesus, that the Father of glory would give unto them the Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

Eph 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

Therefore, the Spirit of the Lord and Father God or the Father of glory are one.

In the Toronto blessing, many broken-hearted and hurting people were healed.

The burnt-out ones were put back on fire and healings and deliverances took place.

This all happened because the Father heart of God was moving and being released through the ministry of the Spirit of the Lord.

For the Spirit of the Lord also releases the glory of God and changes us from glory to glory.

2Co 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

My Inner Healing Testimony

My mother was born out of wedlock, with a secret marriage following, she carried a lot of shame, grief, guilt, abandonment, rejection, and lack of love.

When I was in Toronto, Father God's tender love healed me of these iniquities that I had received from my mother's side of the family.

My daughter, Elisabeth, was 2 years old at this time. The walls between me and her melted away as I received this love that I had never known.

From that time forth, she and I bonded deeply.

Now there is great love, joy and respect between the two of us.

The Spirit of the Lord Gives Deep Intimacy

The Spirit of the Lord, or Father of glory, releases unto us the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so we may know and grow in our intimate relationship with the Godhead.

Eph 1:17 (AMP) (For I always pray to) the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation (of insight into mysteries and secrets) in the (deep and intimate) knowledge of Him.

Through the Holy Spirit, we grow in fellowship or communion.

Therefore, the fullness of the Holy Spirit takes us to higher heights in our fellowship or communion with God.

As we learn to come up higher in our worship before the throne of God, in the fullness, or the 7 Spirits of God, we will be changed.

2Co 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

In this place of worship, the Spirit of the Lord grows us into deep intimacy. We will get to know the Father heart of God in more glorious ways and deeper depths.

Our love for Jesus Christ will grow, for it will be revealed in a greater way the price that He paid for us.

The Menorah and the 7 Spirits

The 7 Spirits of God are revealed to us in the Bible book of Revelations as they burn before the throne of God.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Around the throne is the rainbow glow of the fullness of God.

The 7 Spirits of God give off these colours for they are the manifest presence of God in heaven in the demonstration.

Therefore, every one of the 7 Spirits has a colour.



There is a main or middle candle; this is the Spirit of the Lord.

The colour of the Spirit of the Lord is green or emerald-green.

The Menorah is the earthly sign of the 7 Spirits of God and gives off 7 flames.

Isaiah gave us the 7 names of these 7 Spirits of God.

Isa 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

Through this, we can understand the names and order of the 7 Spirits of God or the Menorah which are before the throne of God.

The other 6 Spirits or flames come in 3 pairs of 2 on the Menorah and before God's throne.

The Spirit of the Lord releases the other 6

The Spirit of the Lord God is the main Spirit.

When the Jewish people light the Menorah, they start with the middle candle first.

Then they have a little candle and light it from the middle candle.

Then they use the little candle to light the 6 other candles.

Therefore, it is the Spirit of the Lord or the Father of glory who releases the other 6 Spirits.

We see this in Ephesians 1: 17 to 19.

1. The Father of glory or the Spirit of the Lord
2. He releases the Spirit of wisdom and revelation
3. This then gives us greater intimate knowledge by the Spirit of knowledge
4. Out of all of this, the Spirit of might is released through the mighty power of God in our lives.

Eph 1:17-19 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: (18) The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, (19) And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

The Spirit of the Lord upon Jesus Christ

When the Lord Jesus Christ had started to minister and evangelise, He gave a powerful speech in Nazareth.

Nazareth was the town Jesus Christ had grown up in.

All the people there knew Him as the carpenter's son.

When the right moment came, He stood up in the synagogue of Nazareth and read from the book Isaiah.

Luk 4:16-19 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read. (17) And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written, (18) The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (19) To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

After that, He said today, this scripture has been fulfilled.

In other words, He said the Spirit of the Lord is upon Me and that is why these miracles, healings, signs and wonders have happened through My life.

Open Heavens

When the Lord Jesus Christ came to John the Baptist to be baptised, the heavens opened.

Luk 3:21 Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened,

Jesus Christ also needed to be baptised for He came as the Messiah and King to the order of the kingdom of God and Melchizedek.

Psa 110:4 The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

He said that all righteousness needed to come to pass.

When the heavens were opened, the Spirit of the Lord came as a dove upon Jesus Christ.

Joh 1:32-33 And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. (33) And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

The Lord Jesus Christ was baptised in water and with the Spirit of the Lord, for He received the Spirit without measure.

For John said that he saw the Spirit descending from heaven above.

The Spirit was the Spirit of the Lord.

Joh 3:34 (AMP) For since He who God has sent speaks the words of God (proclaims God's message) God does not give Him His Spirit sparingly or by measure, but boundless is the gift God makes of His Spirit.

Through this baptism with the Spirit of the Lord God who is also the Father of glory, Jesus Christ had direct communication with Abba Father.

This is why He had such a deep, intimate relationship with Abba Father while on earth.

Out of that deep relationship and fellowship with Abba Father, He ministered and taught us about Father God.

Filled With Power

- Our Lord Jesus ministered out of the fullness.
- The fullness lies in the ministry of the 7 Spirits of God which is the fullness of the Holy Spirit.
- It says that Jesus Christ, full of the Holy Spirit, was led into the wilderness.

Luk 4:1 And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

He fasted for 40 days, and the devil tried to stop His ministry by tempting Him.

Jesus Christ was victorious in the wilderness and returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit.

Luk 4:14 And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

Now the 7 Spirits of God were activated, and mighty power was released into His ministry.

The Spirit of might is the spirit of the 7 that releases the mighty power of God.

This led to the many mighty miracles, deliverances and healings that were taking place.

Mat 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. (24) And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them. (25) And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.

It is all the Work of God's Spirit

It is the Spirit of the Lord God that brings freedom.

2Co 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

Therefore, we need to learn to depend upon the work of the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

Our Lord Jesus Christ is the Son of God and also came as the Son of Man.

He laid down His godly power so he could be like us.

Therefore, the Lord Jesus Christ was dependent upon the fullness of the Holy Spirit of God to do ministry.

All the miracles, signs and wonders in the life of Jesus Christ happened through the fullness of the Holy Spirit or the 7 Spirits of God.

If He was dependent upon the fullness of the Holy Spirit in ministry, so should we.

Therefore, He said to us to pray so that the power of the Holy Spirit would be released unto us.

Act 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

The Spirit of the Lord in Jesus Christ's Evangelistic Healing Ministry

In the synagogue at Nazareth, the Lord Jesus Christ said that the Spirit of the Lord God was upon Him.

Luk 4:18, 21 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (21) And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

- ❖ Here He revealed to us the secrets of His ministry.
- ❖ He said that He did the works of healing, deliverance and proclaiming the evangelistic message through the Spirit of the Lord.

The Spirit of the Lord's ministry:

1. Preaching the gospel
2. Heal the broken-hearted
3. Preach deliverance to the captive
4. Recovery of sight to the blind
5. Bring freedom
6. Preach the acceptable year of the Lord

Luk 4:18,19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (19) To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

The Spirit of the Lord in Benny Hinn's Ministry

Evangelist Benny Hinn knows how to attract the glorious presence of the Lord in a meeting. He knows which songs to sing that will bring down the manifest presence of the Spirit of the Lord. Once the manifest presence of the Spirit of the Lord comes down in a meeting, the signs, wonders and miracles happen.

As this happens, many come to the Lord and receive Him as their Saviour and Redeemer.

I have received several powerful touches as he laid hands on me.

Through this, I have grown in sensitivity to the Spirit of the Lord.

This is a higher level than the anointing.

Therefore, we must come up higher.

The Sick came to Jesus for Healing

As we have now learnt, Jesus Christ did His ministry through the Spirit of the Lord.

He preached the gospel message by the power of the Spirit so there would be the power of the Spirit of the Lord to heal.

Luk 5:17 And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was present to heal them.

Jesus Christ ministered from an open heaven as the Spirit of the Lord was upon Him and then there was power to preach, heal, deliver, and set the demonic possessed free.

As the sunset in Galilee, the sick, possessed and hurting came.

Luk 4:40-41 Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them. (41) And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

They were saved, healed, and delivered for the Spirit of the Lord was upon Jesus Christ and He ministered through the Spirit of the Lord.

Chapter 3: Spirit of Wisdom, Revelation and Evangelism and Worship

Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation

When Apostle Paul prayed for the church at Ephesus, he prayed that the Father of glory would give them a Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

Eph 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

What are these two Spirits of wisdom and revelation that he is praying for?

Well, they are 2 of the 7 Spirits of God.

In this first chapter of Ephesians, Apostle Paul lays out an order of the 7 Spirits of God.

God asked me what the order of the 7 Spirits are?

I said You know Lord, please tell me.

Then the Holy Spirit showed me the order of the 7 Spirits of God laid out in Ephesians 1.

You need to ask the Lord for the operation of the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in your life.

They Come in Pairs

In chapter 2 we talked about the main Spirit of the 7, which is the Spirit of the Lord.

The other six work in pairs.

Isa 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

Isaiah gives us the 7 names.

In Ephesians 1, Apostle Paul gives us the order.

There is one major difference between the two, and this is that he puts in the first place the names of the Spirit of wisdom and the Spirit of revelation.

Then he adds that the eyes of your understanding may be enlightened.

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

He does this to give us a greater view of the mystery of revelation and understanding.

The 7 Spirits Order of Ephesians



Eph 1: 17-19 (AMP)(For I always pray to) the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation (of insight into mysteries and secrets) in the (deep and intimate) knowledge of Him. By having the eyes of your heart flooded with light, so that you can know and understand the hope to which He has called you, and how rich is His glorious inheritances in the saints (His set-apart ones). And (so that you can know and understand) what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength.

The first spirit is the Spirit of the Lord, which he calls here the Father of glory.

Now, remember, the other 6 come in pairs of 2.

Therefore, he says that the Father of glory may give to you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

Eph 1: 17(AMP)(For I always pray to) the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation (of insight into mysteries and secrets) in the (deep and intimate) knowledge of Him.

So, he says that the next 2 are:

- a) Spirit of wisdom
- b) Spirit of revelation (which can also be called understanding)

Then he goes on to say that you may know Him more intimately.

This is the Spirit of knowledge at work.

As they come in pairs, the Spirit of the fear of the Lord is also here which also helps you to grow in intimacy with the Lord.

Mighty Power

In these Last Days, God wants to move in mighty power.

If we want to be used in these Last Day outpourings, we must open ourselves to the fullness of God which operated through the 7 Spirits of God.

Ephesians 1 reveals to us the mysteries of the 7 Spirits of God as found in the New Testament, which is why he finishes by talking about the fullness.

Eph 1:23 (AMP) Which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all (for in that body lives the full measure of Him who makes everything complete, and who fills everything everywhere with Himself).

As we grow in the way Apostle Paul teaches us, we will move in mighty power, so signs, wonders and miracles will happen through us and many will be saved.

That is why he says that this is our inheritance, and that mighty power will flow through our lives.

Eph 1: 19 (AMP) And (so that you can know and understand) what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength.

The Spirit of counsel and might work together, therefore the Spirit of counsel will show us how to move with God's mighty power, which operates in us through the Spirit of might.

Jesus Christ moved with the 7 Spirits

Isaiah prophesied that the 7 Spirits of God would be upon Jesus Christ.

It said that the Spirit of the Lord would rest upon the stem of Jesse, which is Jesus Christ, and all the 7 Spirits would be upon Him.

In the book of Revelations, we see the Lord Jesus Christ as the Lamb of God, with seven horns and seven eyes, which are the 7 Spirits of God.

Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Jesus Christ walked and ministered out of the glory, was full of glory, and ministered out of the fullness, which is the 7 Spirits of God.

Joh 1:14,16 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (16) And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

Therefore, He also ministered out of the Spirit of the Lord, wisdom and revelation.

Jesus Revelation at Samaria's Well

One day, Jesus Christ was on His mission to evangelise a city in Samaria.

The start of this evangelistic mission was by the ministry of the Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

The Spirit of the Lord was upon Jesus Christ and the Spirit of wisdom and revelation flowed abundantly through Him.

By the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, Jesus Christ knew everything about a person's life, for He lived in a river of wisdom and revelation.

He met a Samaritan woman at Jacob's Well who had a lot of questions.

Jesus answered her through the Spirit of wisdom and revelation as they move as a pair.

He said to her, by the Spirit of wisdom, go, call your husband (for He knew she was living in sin).

Joh 4:16 Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.

Jesus set her up to reveal her sins and past to her.

He said that she had had 5 husbands and that the present one that she was living with was not her husband.

Joh 4:17-18 The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband: (18) For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.

She then believed, went to the people in the city who then came and listened to Jesus Christ. Many believed.

Joh 4:39 And many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did.

Wisdom

In Greek, wisdom has two words:

A. Sophia

This gives reference to:

- i) God
- ii) Christ
- iii) Wisdom personified
- iv) Human wisdom

B. Phronesis

This is the ability to discern

Understanding

In Greek understanding has the word *Suniemi*.

It means to bring or set together by:

- a. Perceive
- b. Understand
- c. United

Revelation

In Greek, revelation is *Apokalupsis*.

1. Drawing away the veil of darkness by Christ
2. The mystery of God's purpose is revealed
3. For instruction and guidance
4. Communicate revealed knowledge

Get Understanding

The book of Proverbs, advises us that above all, to get understanding.

Pro 4:7 Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.

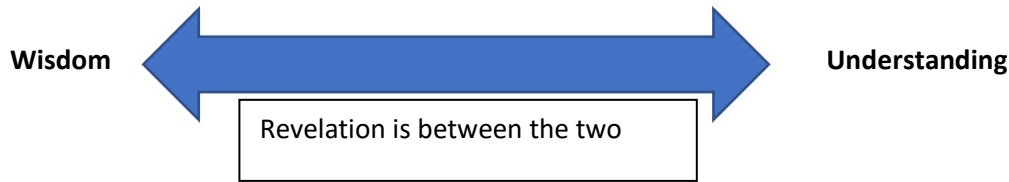
Therefore, understanding is of great importance.

Isaiah puts wisdom and understanding together as a pair.

Paul puts wisdom and revelation together and then talks about the eyes of your understanding.

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Apostle Paul does this because revelation is a very important part of understanding.



Revelation is in between wisdom and understanding.

Revelation gives revelational knowledge, while understanding puts it together, and wisdom knows what and how to employ it.

Apostle Paul understood that without revelation, understanding and wisdom would not function. Therefore, the work of the Holy Spirit and living in the spirit is so important.

Joel's Prophecy

In the realm of revelation, the prophecies of Prophet Joel are so important.

He said that the Holy Spirit would be poured out in the Last Days.

The outworking was that your sons and daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions and the old men shall dream dreams.

Act 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

Why is this prophecy so important? Because it is about the importance of revelation.

Revelation makes things move forward.

We Need Encounters

Encounters bring revelation to us.

In the Bible, we see many encounters.

Encounters are part of revelation and bring understanding.

Gabriel came to Daniel and gave him an understanding of what was happening and coming to pass.

Due to the writings in the book of Revelations, also called the Apocalypse, we know what will happen in these Last Days.

Then, with the Spirit of understanding, we can put one and one together to work out what to do and share that with those around us.

Revelation

Revelation reveals

- Who God is
- The attributes of God
- The things of God
- His plans for you, your ministry and the world
- His agenda

The Cross and the Spirit of Wisdom

The plan of salvation is God's wisdom to us.

The world does not understand God's plan and wisdom.

The Bible says that a fleshly person is foolish and proud and therefore, God has made His salvation plan to shame the worldly-wise and proud.

That is why the Bible calls God's salvation plan, the hidden wisdom of God.

1Co 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

Revelation and Understanding Give Discernment

The Spirit of revelation or understanding releases the higher levels of the gift of discernment.

Discernment is of the Spirit and, therefore, we need revelation and understanding based on the Bible.

The Spirit of revelation, by a word of knowledge or vision, will reveal to us what is the root cause of sickness and what demon could be causing it.

Then we pray in the authority and mighty power of God and see healing and deliverance.

Understanding, wisdom and knowledge are all based upon the fear of the Lord, who is the God of the Bible.

These all will shape our true discernment.

(Pro 1:7) The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Deeper Levels of the Cross

Many believers have a basic understanding of the blood sacrifice of Christ at the cross.

They understand that faith in Christ's redemptions at the cross is the way of salvation.

Yet there are deeper levels of the cross of Christ for daily living, victory and transformation.

Ten years ago, God spoke to me that I needed a deeper understanding of the cross of Christ so that I could then preach and teach this.

He said that many souls would be saved as a result of this.

Also, for the Last Days ministry, we need a deeper understanding of the cross of Christ for daily living, victory and transformation.

This greater understanding comes to us by the Spirit of wisdom, revelation and understanding.

Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation and the Cross

Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of God.

This will be revealed to us more deeply through the Spirit of revelation.

1Co 1:24 But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

God does not want the flesh to glory in His presence, therefore, only through humility and the Spirit of wisdom and revelation will these deeper truths be revealed.

Apostle Paul says that we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even hidden wisdom.

1Co 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

Therefore, the Spirit of revelation has to reveal this hidden wisdom and hidden knowledge to us. That is why Paul says it will be revealed by the Spirit of God.

1Co 2:10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

The natural man received not the things of the Spirit because they are spiritually discerned. Wisdom gives us the ability to discern, therefore, the deeper understanding of the hidden wisdom of the cross of Christ comes to us by the Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

This will enable us to daily be changed by the cross of Christ and grow in victory and be transformed from glory to glory.

Worship and Revelation

Worship releases revelation.

The Father is seeking worshippers who will worship Him in spirit and truth.

Joh 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

Father God wants to be worshipped and we are created for the praise of His glory.

Out of it, God also moves His hand.

Worship is all about Him and pouring ourselves to Him in surrender.

When we worship, revelation flows and demons go.

Bring me a Minstrel for Revelation

The battle is for revelation.

When Israel was in trouble because of their enemies, Jehoshaphat asked to see Prophet Elisha. Elisha wanted to receive revelation from the Lord.

He understood that worship releases revelation.

Therefore, he asked them to bring him a minstrel.

2Ki 3:15 But now bring me a minstrel. And it came to pass, when the minstrel played, that the hand of the LORD came upon him.

Then the hand of the Lord came upon Elisha and he received the plan for victory.

Revelation and Healing

In the ministry of Kathryn Kuhlmann and Benny Hinn, worship was of great importance. As they worshipped, the glory came and then they, through the Spirit of revelation, receive revelational knowledge of people's sicknesses, disease or bondage. As they spoke it out, many were healed by the Spirit of the Lord. Worship releases the Spirit of the Lord to act, and He gives revelation and healing. For He is the Lord that heals you.

(Exo 15:26) And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.

David the Minstrel and Deliverance

David was a worshipper. The Spirit of the Lord God was upon him, especially at times, when King Saul became oppressed by an evil spirit. When that occurred, they would call for David. As David was a minstrel, he worshipped the Lord and the evil spirit departed from King Saul.

1Sa 16:23 And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

Therefore, worship brings forth the Spirit of revelation and deliverance follows.

That is why the Jezebel spirit tries to stop true worship in the church.

The battle is for revelation.

Therefore the 7 Spirits of God takes us to the higher levels of revelation.

For they are the 7 eyes of the Lord.

They are the 7 eyes of the Lord and 7 flames burning.

The fire keeps the darkness out.

These eyes break through the darkness.

They have revelation, discernment and understanding.

Zec 3:9,10 For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the LORD of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day. For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.

The 7 eyes of the Lord run to and fro through the whole earth.

We are in an information war.

The 7 Spirits or 7 eyes bring true revelation, true news.

First Worship in Heaven

In the book of Revelation, we see the scene in heaven and revelations about the End Times.

There is a pattern in heaven.

Every time more revelations are revealed, first, the worship of God must occur.

At every event, we see the 24 Elders or the 4 Living Creatures, saints or angels' worship, then the event takes place.

Fullness of Worship

In August 2021, while I was worshipping, an angel came to me in the spirit and took me to see worship in heaven.

He said that the warrior bride must learn to worship in the fullness, which is the 7 Spirits of God before the throne.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Then the warrior bride will move in the 7 Spirits of God on the earth.

Then she will move with the Spirit of wisdom and revelation.

This will release the Spirit of might and the great signs and wonders will be released.

Then multitudes of souls shall be saved.

Chapter 4: Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of the Lord

So Far:

We are following the pattern or order of the 7 Spirits of God that Apostle Paul gave in the book of Ephesians.

He started with the Spirit of the Lord as the Father of glory.

(Eph 1:17) That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

The Father of glory or the Spirit of the Lord is the first Spirit of the 7 Spirits of God, which we call the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

The Apostle Paul goes onto the next two of the 7 Spirits of God, called the Spirit of wisdom and understanding which he calls the Spirit of revelation.

(Eph 1:17) That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

The fullness of the Spirit of revelation lies in the eye of your understanding being enlightened.

(Eph 1:18) The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

The light of God brings revelation, then we perceive what God is saying.

All of this is part of the Spirit of understanding. Now we can understand what God is saying and put it all together.

The Spirit of Knowledge and the Fear of God

The next one of the 7 Spirits that Apostle Paul mentions, is the Spirit of knowledge.

He says that the former 3 Spirits of God are there to help you to know God more deeply and intimately through the Spirit of knowledge.

(Eph 1:17 AMP) (For I always pray to) the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation (of insight into mysteries and secrets) in the (deep and intimate) knowledge of Him.

Therefore, the Spirit of knowledge is there to help us to become rooted and grounded in the love of God.

(Eph 3:17-19) That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

Spirit of Knowledge and Fullness

Being rooted and grounded in the love of God is instrumental in helping us in this process of being filled with all the fullness of God.

The love of God comes to us through faith in Jesus Christ and in revelational knowledge of who He is.

Therefore, we need revelational knowledge through the Spirit of revelation and the Spirit of knowledge about the heart of Christ.

This will open us up to know the Father heart of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit.

For it says we are to know the love of Christ.

It then shows us that the Spirit of knowledge, which is revelational knowledge, surpasses natural knowledge.

(Eph 3:19) And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

This revelational knowledge about the love of Christ opens us up for the fullness of God.

The fullness of God is the 7 Spirits of God operating in our lives, not just one or two of the 7 Spirits.

A Heavenly Encounter

In 2014, I had an amazing heavenly encounter.

I was in Jerusalem attending a prophetic conference when a golden glory portal opened up.

I was then taken up in the spirit to the streets of gold.

❖ Then I saw the Spirit of the Lord.

He showed me that if we want to come up higher, we must be changed from glory to glory by the Spirit of the Lord.

(2Co 3:17,18) Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

He showed me that being changed from glory to glory comes to us through knowing the glorious love of God.

Therefore, it is the Spirit of knowledge that leads us into the deeper revelational knowledge of the love of Christ and the love of the Father.

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord will help us to be obedient to that revelational knowledge so we will not quench the Spirit of God.

It was then shown to me that as we are growing in this fullness, the Spirit of might will be revealed.

This will lead to many salvations through the Spirit of the fear of the Lord as the mighty miracles are released by the Spirit of might.

Spirit of Knowledge and Spirit of the Fear of the Lord

When we look at the Menorah and Isaiah 11:2, we see that 6 of the 7 Spirits come in pairs.

(Isa 11:2) And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

In Ephesians 1:17 we see the Spirit of knowledge and because they come in pairs, we can understand that the Spirit of the fear of the Lord is also there.

(Eph 1:17) That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

The Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord both help us to grow in a deeper intimacy or fellowship with the Lord.

Spirit of the Fear of the Lord

We can learn in the book of Proverbs that the fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge.

(Pro 1:7) The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

We must cry out for knowledge and understanding.

We must be hungry for it and search for knowledge as hidden treasures.

Then we will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God.

(Pro 2:4-6) If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures; Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God. For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

Here you already see how the fear of the Lord and knowledge go hand in hand.

The fear of the Lord is also the beginning of wisdom.

(Pro 9:10) The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.

Secrets Revealed

When we live in the fear of the Lord and move through the Spirit of fear of the Lord, secrets of the Lord will be revealed to us.

(Psa 25:14) The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

Therefore, the Spirit of the fear of the Lord takes us to the higher levels of the gifts of prophecy and discernment.

In this place, Jesus Christ knew what was in their hearts.

This is also the place of friendship with the Lord and His sweet, satisfying companionship.
The Amplified Bible says that the secret of the sweet, satisfying companionship of the Lord have they who fear Him.

The Right Message Encounter

In 2020, while I was worshipping our Heavenly Father, I had an encounter. Right above me was the Spirit of the Lord. Then the fear of God came upon me and when that happens, you want to hide. The Spirit of the fear of the Lord said, 'Yes, God is going to move in a mighty way.' He then said that even though that would happen, the important thing is that in that time, the right message is preached. This is when I knew on the inside by the Holy Spirit, that the right message is the message of the cross of Christ.

(1Co 2:2) For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

Repentance and the fear of God were also very important. Then I was able to make a teaching series called The School of Cross Fire Evangelism.

The Coming Move of the Fear of God

In 2006, as we were praying, fasting, and doing warfare over a dark region, I had an encounter with the Lord. He showed that we must learn to live in the holy fiery presence of God. In this place, our fleshly walk and compromise are being burnt up by God's holy fire. Then God showed me that in the Last Days, He is going to move over the land by the Spirit of the fear of the Lord. This will lead people to get together in town halls and gathering places where great conviction of sin will move over the people. In those days, many are going to get saved and great healings will take place.

Apostle Peter and the Fear of God

On the day of Pentecost, Apostle Peter was baptised with the Holy Spirit and fire. Later, they were also baptised with boldness as the building had been shaken by God's power. Yet, there was more to come. Peter was growing in fullness and one day, the Spirit of the fear of the Lord moved through him as he received revelation about sin in a couple's life. The couple's names were Ananias and Sapphira. Peter said, Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit. Ananias and Sapphira both tried to deceive Peter, and both fell dead. For Peter said that they had deceived the Holy Spirit.

(Act 5:1-5) But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet. But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was

sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.

Our God is Holy

Our God is holy!

The angels cry holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Hosts.

(Isa 6:3) And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

The mountains melt like wax in the presence of a holy God

(Psa 97:5) The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.

Holy means morally pure, sacred, and complete.

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord releases the holy presence of God in a meeting or over a region.

This will bring people and believers to a place where they are convicted of sin.

Sometimes, God gives unbelievers visions of hell and heaven when the conviction power of the Spirit of the fear of the Lord is moving.

Hebrides Awakening

From 1948 to 1952 there was an awakening happening in the Hebrides.

The difference between a revival and an awakening is that in the revival, the believers or church is revived from lukewarmness to hot, whereas an awakening is when the world is convicted of sin and they start to repent.

In the Hebrides awakening, both happened because the Spirit of the fear of the Lord moved over these islands, especially the Island of Lewis.

The Hebrides is a small group of Islands on the west coast of Scotland.

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord reveals and releases the holy nature and holy presence of God.

When this happens, the common people see that they are sinners and start to repent or seek repentance, just as it happened on the Hebrides.

(Rom 3:23) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

The moving of the Spirit of the fear of the Lord releasing the holy presence of God on the Hebrides often happened during the night-time, sinners would wake up and feel God's conviction power upon them.

House after house, the same thing happened, people would come out of their houses into the streets, start wailing and mourning for they knew they were not right with God.

Just before this happened, God had sent Duncan Campbell to the islands to preach.

The evangelist would preach, and the wailing people would get saved as they gave their lives to Christ.

The Police Station

This is an account of the revival from the book written by Kathie Walters about the Hebrides revival:

“As the meeting was closing, someone excitedly hurried to the preacher, Come with me! There is a crowd of people outside the police station, they are weeping and in great distress. We don’t know what’s wrong with them, but they are calling for someone to come and pray with them. The minister described the scene outside the police station. ‘I saw a sight I never thought possible. Something I shall never forget. Under a starlit sky, men and women were kneeling everywhere, by the roadside, outside the cottages, even behind the peat stacks, crying for God to have mercy on them. Nearly six hundred people making their way to church suddenly experienced the power of God falling upon them in great conviction, and like Paul on the road to Damascus, fell to their knees in repentance.’” (Walters, K. 2006:11)

Once these people were saved, they experienced God’s great mercy, love, and grace in their lives, because of that many songs were made about God’s great love.

The Spirit of the Fear of the Lord upon Jesus Christ.

Jesus ministered out of the fullness.

Therefore, He had communion and union with the holy presence of Father God.

That is why he called Father God, Holy Father.

(Joh 17:11) And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.

Therefore, in the Lord’s prayer, He taught that the Father’s name is holy.

Out of this holy presence, through the Spirit of fear of the Lord, the holy fire was released in Jesus’ ministry.

Therefore, the demons cried out when Jesus was preaching. They were tormented by the holy fire of God that was present in those meetings.

We see this in His ministry in Capernaum.

Jesus Ministry at Capernaum

Jesus went to minister in Capernaum.

(Luk 4:31-36) And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days. And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power. And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice, Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God. And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not. And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

We can see here that the Spirit of the fear of the Lord was in that place as the demons cried out.

The things we can learn here about the Spirit of the fear of the Lord are:

1. The Spirit of the fear of the Lord releases the power of God.
The demon said that He was the holy one of God.
2. The Spirit of the fear of the Lord releases the gift of discernment.
For Jesus said that the demons were to hold their peace and come out!
We also see this discernment being used by Apostle Paul when he cast out the fortune-telling spirit from the woman at the church in Philippi.
3. The Spirit of the fear of the Lord releases great authority.

(Luk 4:36) And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

The people saw that with authority and power, Jesus cast out the many unclean spirits, spirits of infirmity, the spirit of deafness, and blind and dumb spirits.

Jesus Knew their Hearts

In different parts of the gospels, It says that Jesus knew their hearts.

(Mat 22:18) But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye me, ye hypocrites?

Jesus Christ's delight was in the reverential and obedient fear of the Lord.

(Isa 11:3) And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

The fear of the Lord releases secrets, revelations, discernment, etc.

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord releases:

- Rivers of revelation, discernment, and mysteries that are revealed.
- Rivers of knowledge and gift of knowledge.
- Rivers of wisdom and gift of wisdom.

The Pharisees tried to trick Jesus.

They asked Him if they should give tax to Caesar.

It then says that Jesus perceived their wickedness.

(Mat 22:18) But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye me, ye hypocrites?

Then the Spirit and gift of wisdom worked through Christ and He answered back with wisdom.

He said, show me the money and asked whose face it was on the coin.

He then said, give to Caesar what belongs to him.

So, they marvelled and walked away.

True Repentance by Secrets Revealed

In many churches, they have used the gift of prophecy, yet there is a higher level of prophecy available which brings sinners to repentance.

This is when the person's secrets are released.

These higher revelations come in our midst through the working of the Spirit of the fear of the Lord.

Apostle Paul also walked in the fullness and knew that God is holy.

He understood the working of the Spirit of fear of the Lord and that it would reveal the secrets of a person's heart.

(1Co 14:24) But if all prophesy, and there come in one that believeth not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he is judged of all: And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a truth.

As these secrets of their hearts were revealed in the church at Corinth, then they would be convicted and could get saved.

Chapter 5: Spirit of Counsel and Might and Deliverance

Counsel and Might

As we look at the Menorah or the 7-armed candlestick, we follow the order that is laid out in Ephesians 1.

We see the Spirit of counsel and might are the last pair in Ephesians 1, which means they are the outermost arms of the candlestick on both sides.

Counsel is the orange colour and might is the indigo colour.

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

It says here that the eyes of your understanding are enlightened, that you may know the riches of the glory of the inheritance in the saints.

As we have received revelation through God's light or Spirit of revelation and we understand, then the Spirit of counsel knows what to do and counsels us how to move with God's mighty power to see the will of God come forth.

Eph 1:19 And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

When it says here, according to the working of His mighty power, this is the working of the Spirit of might.

Apostle Paul, Counsel and Discernment

Through the Spirit of counsel, we will go through God's refiner's fire and know His will, ways, word and purpose.

Therefore, counsel will release a higher level of the gift of discernment in our lives.

1Co 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

We see this Spirit of counsel and discernment operating in Apostle Paul's life when he delivers the fortune-telling witch in Philippi.

At the end of the story, there is a mighty move of evangelism, leading to the birth and establishment of the Philippians Church through the Spirit of might.

This is because the Spirit of counsel and might work together.

In this chapter, we will be looking at the Spirit of counsel and in the next chapter, we will look at the Spirit of might.

A Beautiful Sunset

One day, when we were on a spiritual retreat in the mountains and hills of O'Reillys, I saw a beautiful sunset.

The sky was mostly a bright orange colour with an orange glow.

The Spirit of counsel makes known to us the heart of God and the love of the bridegroom for us.

The colour of the Spirit of counsel is orange.

A beautiful sunset is a place of romance and the bridegroom wants to release His love to His bride today.

Then I saw a bird with an orange colour called a Rufous fantail.

In the Song of Solomon, it says to come away with the Lord, and He calls you His bride and His banner over you is love.

Son 2:4 He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.

Secrets

Counsel is also connected to the revealing of secrets.

(Job 15:8 AMP) Were you present to hear the secret counsel of God? And do you limit (the possession) of wisdom to yourself?

The Spirit of counsel also reveals the secrets of the heart of God.

Moses wanted to see the secret glory of God.

He prayed for it and God showed His glory to him.

(Exo 33:22) And it shall come to pass, while my glory passeth by, that I will put thee in a clift of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by:

God revealed His heart filled with glorious goodness, love and kindness.

All through the Bible, we see this secret counsel given to Moses, revealed through prophets like David and Isaiah and others, always revealing God's heart.

(Psa 103:13) Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him.

Therefore, the Spirit of counsel makes known to us the nature, attributes and heart of God.

Friends

Counsel releases our destiny.

Listen to the Father God's will every day.

This will release more of God's Spirit of counsel in your life.

When we do God's will, we learn to walk in His ways.

As we do this, we become friends of God, for as we walk in His counsel, we also in the fear of God and become His friends.

(Psa 25:14) The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

Buy Gold

In Greek, the word for counsel is *sumboulion*.

This means:

- a) Advice

- b) Instruction
- c) Advice or counsel given and acted upon

In the book of Revelations, we see the Spirit of counsel at work.

God wants to take us up higher and gives us advice or counsel on how to get up higher. We are called to act upon it.

It says I counsel thee to buy gold from Me.

Rev 3:18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

Gold, White Clothes and Eye salve

The counsel of the Lord on how to come up higher is given in Revelations 3.

God wants us, in a relational (as bridegroom and bride) and victorious way, to be overcomers so we can sit with Him on His throne.

Therefore, He wants us to burn with the 7 Spirits of God who are before the throne.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

To do so, we are counselled here to buy gold, white clothes, and eye salve.

Rev 3:17-18 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: (18) I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

We think we are all good, but to live in the fullness, we have to be changed from glory to glory.

God wants to cleanse us from our sin, character faults and deceptions, so we can walk in purity as the true bride who puts on new, clean, white raiment.

Counsel at the Papaya Tree

In 1986, I was in Ghana, Africa when the Lord gave me counsel using a papaya tree (Pawpaw tree).

I was a leader in a mission school, and we were about to head out on the outreach.

Our visas were stopped, so I could not lead the team on this evangelistic outreach.

I had to go to a neighbouring country of Togo.

I was staying there on a mission base and there was a papaya tree.

The Lord counselled me by saying "look at the papaya tree".

The tree was overfull with little fruit.

The Lord said that as those fruits grew and the strong winds would blow, the tree would fail and fall.

Then He said this is how your life would be if you would, as a young believer, have led the outreach team. You would be used in a great way, yet pride would come, and your spiritual life would fall.

Two weeks later, the fruits had grown, yet a storm came, and the tree broke at the roots and the fruits were smashed.

Then the Lord counselled me from Revelations 3 and said that I was to buy gold of Him. This led me to be broken before the presence of God, repenting of my pride, stubbornness and self-will. I learnt to buy gold refined by fire.

7 Eyes

The 7 Spirits of God are also the 7 Eyes of God who run to and fro, through the whole earth. They see everything that is going on on the earth, yet they are also burning before the throne of God.

Zec 4:10 For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.

Our Lord Jesus Christ ministered in the fullness of the 7 Spirits of God, also the 7 eyes of the Spirit in heaven were within Him.

Now, Christ knows what is happening throughout the whole earth.

Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

The word counsel also includes instruction and guiding.

Psa 73:24 Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me to glory.

A guide is like a pilot sent to a ship who is to go through the shallow water in a river with banks to safely bring it to the port city.

On earth, the Lord Jesus Christ saw what the Father was doing through the eye of the Spirit of counsel and, therefore, knew what to do.

Joh 5:19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

Therefore, Jesus Christ walked under the counsel of Father God through the Spirit of counsel.

This means that God's eye is around us.

Therefore, He will counsel us with His eye upon us.

Our eyes of our understanding need to be filled with the light of His revelation so we will know His counsel and act upon it.

Psa 32:8-9 I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye. (9) Be ye not as the horse, or as the mule, which have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee.

We are warned not to be like a horse or mule, who are stubborn and lack understanding, they do not want to be guided.

Therefore, we need to act upon the revelation and counsel to be obedient.

Counsel and the Fear of God

The Spirit of counsel goes together with the Spirit of might.

The Spirit of might releases power, miracles, signs and wonders, breakthrough and deliverance.

Therefore, Apostle Paul puts the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of God before the Spirit of counsel and might.

Apostle Paul does this because power can puff up, make us proud. Absolute power can corrupt.

The Spirit of the fear of the Lord also brings transparency, discipleship, integrity and cultivates the fruit of the Spirit and godliness.

Therefore, the Spirit of counsel will counsel us, when we are falling, to go back to the Spirit of the fear of the Lord so we can be changed from glory to glory.

Jer 23:18 For who hath stood in the counsel of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard it?

Jeremiah and Counsel of God

Jeremiah says who of these prophets has stood in the counsel of the Lord.

(Jer 23:18) For who hath stood in the counsel of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard it?

They had not stood in the counsel, did not hear God's word, yet they ran.

They were false prophets and had committed adultery.

(Jer 23:14) I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing: they commit adultery, and walk in lies: they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness: they are all of them unto me as Sodom, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah.

Then Jeremiah goes on to say that if they had stood in God's counsel, then they would have told the people to hear Gods' words so they could have turned from their evil ways.

(Jer 23:22) But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

Therefore, counsel also calls people to turn, which is the same as calling them to repentance.

Jesus Christ counsels us that we can know if people are true or false prophets by their fruit.

True prophets have the fruits of the Spirit in their lives and the fruit of godliness.

(Mat 7:15-20) Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves. Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

Do Not Be A Fool

The Spirit of counsel instructs us to live by the wisdom of God that is found in the preaching of the cross of Christ.

(1Co 1:23, 24) But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

We need to grow daily in this wisdom so that Christ is formed inside of us.

Fools despise instruction.

(Pro 1:5) A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels:

(Pro 1:7) The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

In the Last Days, a lot of preachers will try to run with the 7 Spirits of God yet will only go ankle-deep.

They will not let the Lord change them on the inside and stay in their foolish ways.

Only true surrender will take us deeper.

Therefore, do not be fooled by preachers who say we move with the 7 Spirits of God but do not have the fruits of the Holy Spirit.

Integrity and Godliness

These people have not stood in the true counsel of God.

They did not hear God and repent of their evil ways.

The true Spirit of counsel brings us to repentance and godly fruit-bearing in the Spirit of the fear of the Lord.

(2Pe 1:3-6) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness.

Sin of Balaam

Apostle Peter said we must let the true light shine in us, the true prophetic daystar.

(2Pe 1:3) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

He warns us about false prophets just like Balaam arising in the Last Days.

(2Pe 2:14,15) Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children: Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

Balaam said God's people cannot be cursed.

He then counselled the king to bring the men of Israel into idolatry and fornication with his women so that this would bring a curse upon them from God Himself.

Jesus warned the church at Pergamum about the sin of Balaam.

(Rev 2:14) But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

Today, this sin is also in the church.

The true Spirit of counsel will warn us of this sin and guide us away from it.

Apostle Paul in Philippi

Apostle Paul was on his way to prayer in Philippi when he went past a woman who was possessed with the spirit of fortune-telling and divination.

(Act 16:16 AMP) As we were on our way to the place of prayer, we were met by a slave girl who was possessed by a spirit of divination (claiming to foretell future events and to discover hidden knowledge) and she brought her owners much gain by her fortune-telling.

By the spirit of divination, she proclaimed that Paul and Silas were servants of the Most High God and showed the way to salvation.

This happened for many days.

(Act 16:17,18) The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.

Apostle Paul, who moved in the fullness of the Holy Spirit, by the Spirit of counsel discerned that this was a deceiving spirit that was trying to flirt with them.

Paul, grieved by the Holy Spirit, cast that demon out in the name of Jesus Christ.

This demon wanted to destroy his ministry by making him work from a New Age spirit.

It was a set-up, yet after it was cast out, it stirred up the people against them.

They were beaten and put in prison.

While in prison, in the middle of the night, they sang to God, they started to praise and worship.

(Act 16:25) And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

God wants us to praise and worship in the fullness of the 7 Spirits burning before the throne so that God will be glorified and then He will send His angels to rescue us.

(Rev 4:5) And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

The Spirit of might was released and the jail and region were shaken by an earthquake.

All those in the jail and the region knew that it was an act of God.

The prison-keeper, who wanted to kill himself, was then saved and baptised along with his whole household.

(Act 16:33) And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.

This is the powerful outworking of the Spirit of counsel and the Spirit of might working together.

David Wilkerson

David Wilkerson was an evangelist prophet who truly stood in the counsel of God.

In a strong vision, God showed him the things to come.

He had to call the people to repentance.

Yet many preachers did not like his ministry for it confronted their lifestyles.

There was a strong fire of conviction of sin upon his life, many repented and were made ready for the Last Days.

He did say there would be a harvest of souls when the hard times would start, just before the coming of Jesus Christ.

Chapter 6: The Spirit of Might and Mighty Power

Spirit of Might

The Spirit of might is the release of the Lion of Judah.

It is the Lion of the tribe of Judah that overcame.

(Rev 5:5) And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

The Lion of the tribe of Judah is released through our praises.

The Lion of Judah brings victory, breakthroughs and miracles.

Today, the Lion of Judah wants to roar from the heavenly throne through the Spirit of might and release breakthrough by the power of the kingdom of God and the victorious realm of the holy angel army.

As a Pair

The Spirit of counsel and the Spirit of might go together as a pair.

(Isa 11:2) And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

The Menorah is a type of the 7 Spirits and according to the order of the book of Ephesians, they are on the outside.

The colour associated with the Spirit of might is indigo.

In chapter 5, we saw how Apostle Paul and Silas were beaten and thrown in prison.

In prison, they prayed and praised the Lord. Then the Lion of the tribe of Judah arose.

The mighty power of God's Spirit of might brought an earthquake.

They were set free and the jailer and his whole household were saved.

This is the effect of the restoration of the fallen hut of David.

In Christ and through Christ, our praises go up to the throne of God, which in the New Testament, is the hut of David.

King David a Worshipper and a Mighty Warrior

King David was anointed by Prophet Samuel to be the next king.

King David loved to worship the Lord as he was working as a shepherd herding the sheep.

When he was worshipping, the anointing and the glory of the Spirit of the Lord would rest upon Him.

When there was a battle with a bear or a lion, the Spirit of might would come upon him and he would become a mighty man.

At times, when King Saul was plagued by a devil, they would ask David to come to play for King Saul and the evil spirit would leave.

Here we see the Spirit of might in action against the evil spirit.

True Discernment

The Spirit of counsel brings discernment, for true counsel is based upon the fear of God, so we work with the true power and might of God.

There are many counterfeit powers at work today.

The bible and the nature or attributes of God are true grounds for discernment.

King David is a prophetic type of the Messiah, which is Jesus Christ.

It is all about Jesus Christ and His redeeming sacrifice at the cross.

Prophetic Biblical Types of King David

1. Tabernacle of David
(Act 15:16) After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up;
2. Keys of David
(Rev 3:7) And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;
3. Lion of the tribe of Judah
(Rev 5:5) And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.
4. Throne of David
(Luk 1:32) He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:
5. City of David
(Luk 2:11) For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

No Star of David

The true symbol for Israel is the Menorah or the 7-armed candlestick.

There is no star of David in the Bible.

Do your research into this topic.

It is an occult symbol of Molech.

It is an evil infiltration symbol that has crept in for the nation of Israel and believers.

It releases the evil forces of darkness which is an evil fallen power.

Holy is the Lord of Hosts

The God who created heaven and earth, who is the God of the Bible, is holy.

Holy means:

- A. Sacred
- B. Morally pure
- C. Complete

In heaven, everyone is worshipping our holy God and the Seraphim angels say holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Hosts.

(Isa 6:3) And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

Our holy God is also a consuming fire and out of this holy fire, the 7 Spirits of God burn with holy fire.

(Rev 4:5) And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Therefore, the Spirit of might is part of the fullness of the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit is holy.

If we work with this high level of the holy presence of God through the Spirit of might, it will release breakthrough, yet because God is holy, it can also release judgement.

That is why King David repented after his sin with Bathsheba and said please do not take the presence of your Spirit from me.

(Psa 51:11) Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.

Lord of the Angel Armies

Our Lord and God, who is holy, is also the Lord of the angel armies.

(Isa 6:3) And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

These angel armies also release the glory of God and mighty power.

We see this at the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ.

(Luk 2:8,9) And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

In Hebrew, they call him Lord Sabaoth.

This means the Lord of the angel armies.

It says that we are predestined, by His counsel, to the praise of His glory.

(Eph 1:11,12) In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.

Therefore, through the Spirit of counsel, we will praise the Lord and the Lord of Hosts will release His angel armies into His victorious battle.

Victory, breakthrough and the miracles of the Spirit of might will be released by the Spirit of might.

Thus Saith the Lord of Hosts

Sometimes God spoke to David through the Prophet Nathan.

In these times, God would call Himself the Lord of Hosts

God said to Prophet Nathan, tell King David, thus said the Lord of Hosts.

(2Sa 7:8) Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over my people, over Israel:

Therefore, King David knew God as the Lord of Hosts.

He understood that the Lord of Host would bring victory, by the Lord's mighty power and by His angel armies.

When they praised the Lord, the evil kings would be bound and destroyed.

(Psa 149:6-8) Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand; To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people; To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron.

Tabernacle of David

King David was called to build the tabernacle of David in Zion.

In the New Testament, this is called the restoration of the fallen hut of David.

(Act 15:16) After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up:

Zion or the tabernacle of David is the place where 3000 Levite priests were called to worship the God of Israel before the Ark of the Covenant.

(1Ch 16:1) So they brought the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God.

(1Ch 16:4) And he appointed certain of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel:

(1Ch 16:6) Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the ark of the covenant of God.

Therefore, the Lord of Hosts and the Lord of the angel armies were worshipped in Zion, Israel on earth.

Therefore, King David's armies saw victories in their natural battles.

This became Israel's greatest time of taking in new territories.

The worship of the Lord of Hosts was very important, and we see this pattern again and again in the book of Psalms.

Mighty in Battle

When David was in the fields looking after the sheep, he would be worshipping the Lord on his harp. When a bear or a lion would come, the Spirit of might would come upon him and he became a mighty man.

It was the Spirit of might that he was able to take on the lion and the bear and kill them.

Later, David had 300 mighty men who learnt to move with him under the Spirit of might and defeat their enemies.

Lord of Host, Mighty in Battle

When King David put the Levitical priest in front of the Ark, he learnt that the Lord of the angel armies is mighty in battle.

(Psa 24:8,9) Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

He teaches us these keys of the Lord of Hosts in the book of Psalms.

He says that the King of glory is mighty in battle.

Then he also says that the Lord of Hosts is the King of glory.

Therefore, when we worship the Lord of Hosts, the glory will be released, and the angel armies will do the battle of the Lord.

The Spirit of Might and Release of Angels

Judah means praise.

Jesus Christ is the Lion of Judah who is seated on the throne of heaven.

The throne of King David was a prophetic type of God's throne.

(Luk 1:32) He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

When the King of glory, who is also the Lion of the tribe of Judah roars, the angel armies are released.

Our praise and worship to Him release Him to roar and then releases His angels of war, or as messengers, flames of fire or angels who release revival and miracles.

The Lord roars through the Spirit of might, through His saints and releases heavenly armies.

Council in Jerusalem and David's Tabernacle

The apostles in the first church met together and they called this meeting the council of Jerusalem. They had some disagreements to settle.

Then the Spirit of counsel came upon James, he then said that God was rebuilding the tabernacle of David.

The result of this would be that the nations would come and receive Christ as Lord.

Acts 15:16,17

Our Lord Jesus had said, now is the time to worship the Father in spirit and truth.

(Joh 4:24) God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

When Jesus Christ died, the veil was rent before the Ark so that now we can worship God before the throne in heaven.

This is the New Testament way of the restored tabernacle of David that James talked about.

Therefore, we can behold Him and are changed from glory to glory by the Lord who is that Spirit.

(2Co 3:17,18) Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Angelic Vision

In August 2021, I had an angelic vision.

He asked me what I wanted.

I said miracles for the salvation of many souls.

He then showed me the ladder that was shown to Jacob.

Angels were ascending and descending.

He said, go up, so in the spirit, I went up as I was worshipping at the keyboard.

Then I saw a vision of many angels worshipping in heaven.

Two weeks later, in a vision, the angel showed me the angels worshipping in heaven, yet said, you must go up higher still.

He then showed me the 7 Spirits of God before the throne of God.

He then said you must learn to worship in the 7 Spirits of God for worship is from the Spirit of God.

Then in the vision, the angel said, let the heavenly sounds from the throne room of worship of the 7 Spirits of God flow through you as you worship the Father in spirit and truth.

Then, through the Spirit of might, the breakthrough will come, salvation and miracles will flow.

Jesus Walked in Mighty Power

Our Lord Jesus praised and worshipped Abba Father. He also was in deep union with the Father.

Through the Spirit of counsel, He saw and knew what the Father was doing.

(Joh 5:19,20) Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.

Then, out of the fullness, He did the works of God.

Multitudes would be healed and set free as He was moving in the Spirit of might.

(Mat 4:24) And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

Our Lord Jesus Christ walked in mighty power and moved with great authority.

The Mighty Power of the Holy Spirit

It says that after Jesus had fasted 40 days in the wilderness, He was filled with mighty power.

(Luk 4:14) And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

The word power in Greek is *Dunamis* and it has different meanings, one of them is might. Therefore, it was mighty power whereby the Holy Spirit worked miracles and deliverance through Jesus Christ's ministry.

It was the mighty power of the Spirit of might that delivered the sick people from their demons and healed them.

There was a man brought to Jesus Christ, the man was born blind and dumb. Yet it says that the man was possessed of the devil.

(Mat 12:22,23) Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw. And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David?

Jesus, through the Spirit of might which released mighty power, cast out the demon and then healed the man of his blindness and dumbness.

Then the man was able to see and hear.

Anointed and Filled with Mighty Power

Apostle Peter preached to Cornelius and his people, telling them that God had anointed Jesus Christ of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power.

(Act 10:38 AMP) How God anointed and consecrated Jesus of Nazareth with the (Holy) Spirit and with strength and ability and power; how He went about doing good and, in particular, curing all who were harassed and suppressed by (the power of) the devil, for God was with Him.

He then goes on to say that this mighty power drove out the demons and healed the sick.

Jesus moved out of the fullness of the Holy Spirit and, therefore, moved with the different kinds of power of the Holy Spirit.

He moved in Anointing, Strength, Might, Ability and Power

For there are different flows of power.

In Greek, it shows that there are 6 different words connected with the word power.

The 6 Greek words for power are:

1. *Dunamis* which is power, ability and might. Also, the ability (power) to perform signs and wonders.
2. *Exousia* is an authority that is the right to exercise power or the right to act.
3. *Ischus* is an ability, force, strength.
4. *Kratos* is power or strength.

5. *Dunaton* which is powerful, to make His power known.
6. *Arche* which is to rule.

Power in Action

The Amplified Bible gives us some insight and understanding about this.

(Act 10:38 AMP) How God anointed and consecrated Jesus of Nazareth with the (Holy) Spirit and with strength and ability and power; how He went about doing good and, in particular, curing all who were harassed and suppressed by (the power of) the devil, for God was with Him.

It first says:

1. How God anointed Jesus Christ
2. With strength or might
3. Ability
4. Power

Here we see some of the different flows of power in action as Jesus Christ ministered.
He was ministering with different flows of power at the same time.

The Government on His Shoulders

Isaiah prophesied that the government of God would be upon the shoulders of Jesus Christ.

(Isa 9:6) For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

One of the words for power in Greek is *Arche*, where we get the word Archangel from.
This means rulers or ruling angels in authority and power.

Through the anointing of the Spirit of the Lord God, which is also the Spirit of glory, Jesus Christ had the governmental power upon Him.

Therefore, He had *exousia* or authority, which means the right to exercise power.

Out of this, He could exercise power to cast out demons and to do signs, wonders and miracles.

Therefore, many believed and were redeemed and saved.

By this miracle, He also showed that He had the authority to forgive sins, for the demonic sickness had come through sin.

Glory and Might

In Psalm 24, our Lord is called the King of glory and mighty in battle.

(Psa 24:8) Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.

The Father of glory wants to give us a Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so we understand that the mighty Spirit of the Lord raised Christ from the dead lives in us.

Jesus was anointed with this Spirit of glory which is the Spirit of the Lord.

He said that the Spirit of the Lord is upon Him, therefore He was called to preach the gospel, save, deliver and heal.

(Luk 4:18) The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Yet glory and might work together to set the captives free.

For Jesus Christ is the King of glory and mighty in battle.

Then, in the synagogue in Capernaum, Jesus drove out an unclean spirit.

The people saw the authority, anointing, and power of God work in that place.

(Luk 4:35,36) And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not. And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

Lord of Hosts

The Lord of Hosts is mighty in battle.

This is where the Spirit of might is put to work.

The Spirit of might is the Lion of the Judah roaring and the Spirit of breakthrough.

The Spirit of might releases mighty power and miracles.

(Luk 9:43) And they were all amazed at the mighty power of God. But while they wondered every one at all things which Jesus did, he said unto his disciples,

The Spirit of might is also the realm where the mighty, holy angels are released into battle for the battle belongs to the Lord of Hosts.

There are angels of power, angels of might and archangels of mighty power.

(2Pe 2:11) Whereas angels, which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them before the Lord.

In the Hebrew and Jewish writings, it says there are 7 archangels, and one is called Raphael.

He is sent out of Yahweh Rapha's presence to assist in healing.

Jesus Christ Glory and Might

Our Lord Jesus Christ was anointed with the anointing of the Spirit of the Lord who is also the Spirit of glory.

He moved with glory, might and miracles.

Therefore, the mighty miracles happened through Him for He moved in the different flows of power. In Greek, the word for miracle is *Dunamis* which means the ability to perform miracles, signs and wonders through God's power.

(Joh 2:11) This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

The first wonder that was performed by Jesus Christ, out of God's glory and might, was changing water into wine.

In the entire ministry of Jesus Christ were many holy angels involved who served God and Christ. They helped Christ minister deliverance, healing, signs and wonders.

Now, as His disciples, we are called to follow the pathway of Jesus Christ as He used signs, wonders and miracles to win many souls so they would believe.

(Joh 4:48) Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

Time to Worship

Now is the time to worship the Father in spirit and truth.

As we worship, we are in the New Testament tabernacle of David era, which is worship before the throne of God in heaven.

As we worship in the fullness of our heavenly Father, the Spirit of might will be released.

Many will be saved, and great miracles will happen as a sign that Jesus Christ is Lord.

Chapter 7: The Glory Upon and Within

Shekinah Glory

The Shekinah glory was the manifest presence of God.

- ❖ The Shekinah glory manifested in Israel as a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night.

(Exo 13:21) And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:

- ❖ According to Jewish historians, the pillar of fire was a yellowish golden colour.

The Ark of the Covenant and the presence of God was always at the front of the procession.

The Ark of the Covenant is a prophetic symbol of heaven's throne.

When the people of Israel did right in the sight of God, God blessed them, provided for them, healed them and gave them victory over their enemies.

Gold

- ❖ The Ark of the Covenant was overlaid with pure gold.

(Exo 25:11-13) And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, within and without shalt thou overlay it, and shalt make upon it a crown of gold round about. And thou shalt cast four rings of gold for it, and put them in the four corners thereof; and two rings shall be in the one side of it, and two rings in the other side of it. And thou shalt make staves of shittim wood, and overlay them with gold.

- ❖ Gold is a sign of the Shekinah glory of God.
- ❖ Therefore, our Lord Jesus Christ says come and buy gold from Me that has been refined by fire.

(Rev 3:18) I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

The Golden Menorah

The Ark of the Covenant is overlaid with pure gold.

The Menorah or 7-armed lampstand is also made of pure gold.

It was one piece of pure molten gold.

The builders had to hammer it out of one piece of pure gold into the design given of the 7-armed candlestick.

The holy presence, glory and 7 Spirits of God are one.

Jesus Christ, the Father and the fullness of the Holy Spirit are one.

Therefore, Jesus said I am in the Father and the Father is in Me.

(Joh 14:10) Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

Jesus said that I and the Father are one.

In Israel, they have a saying: The Lord thy God is one God.

(Deu 6:4,5) Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

The Menorah was one piece, one God.

(Exo 25:31) And thou shalt make a candlestick of pure gold: of beaten work shall the candlestick be made: his shaft, and his branches, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, shall be of the same.

This shows you that the 7 Spirits of God are holy flames of fire that make us grow into the holy glorious presence of God.

7 Holy Flames

The Holy Spirit's first name is Holy!

The 7 Spirits of God are the full manifestation of the Holy Spirit.

Therefore, the 7 Spirits of God are 7 holy flames, 7 holy rivers and holy powers of God.

(Rev 4:5) And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

The anointing comes from the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

Yet, the anointing and blessings are not who God is but what He has.

Therefore, we need to let the 7 flames of the 7 Spirits of God purify us and deal with our motivations.

The Spirit Upon and Within

Today many do not walk in or experience the fullness.

The cry of the Spirit of God is to come up higher into the fullness.

The cry of the Holy Spirit is that you come up into the 7 Spirits of God burning before the throne.

The promise is that the Holy Spirit will be upon us and work within us.

Many have settled with only a small measure of the Holy Spirit within.

The move of God's Spirit upon us and flowing like rivers flowing out of us is found by tarrying at the cross of Christ for purification and much prayer and worship in the New Testament tabernacle of David style.

Therefore, Jesus Christ told His disciples to tarry, wait, pray and worship in Jerusalem.

The promise was that the power of the Holy Spirit would come upon us.

(Act 1:8) But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

The Spirit upon is for service in the kingdom of God.

To be a witness, to be a preacher under the unction of the Holy Spirit.

Zechariah's Heavenly Menorah Vision

Zechariah had a heavenly vision of the lampstand or Menorah.

(Zec 4:2,3) And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof: And two olive trees by it, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof.

Why did he receive the vision this way and not the way that Moses had seen it and made the lampstand in the tabernacle?

I have had 2 strong heavenly visions of the heavenly 7-armed candlestick or lampstand.

God wanted to show me the importance of Zechariah's vision.

There is a big difference between the vision of Zechariah's 7-armed candlestick and Moses's 7-armed candlestick.

The Difference

The difference here is that there are 2 olive trees in the picture.

These 2 olive trees let their oil flow into a big bowl.

7 pipes run the oil from the bowl up the 7 lamps to feed it the oil so they will keep burning.

The 2 Olive Trees

The oil for the 7 pipes and 7 lamps come from the 2 olive trees.

(Zec 4:3) And two olive trees by it, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof.

The 2 olive trees are a picture of Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit.

The Bible says that Jesus Christ is the anointed one, through Him, we abide in the Father.

The Holy Spirit releases the anointing and is heaven's river that flows from the throne.

Explanation of the Vision

What the Lord wants us to see here is that the oil of the Spirit is upon the 7 lamps and within the 7 lamps.

The oil comes upon to activate the lamps and goes within for a constant burning.

Here we see the importance of the Holy Spirit upon us and within us.

We need the Holy Spirit upon us.

We need the Holy Spirit within us.

The Spirit of the Lord is Upon Me

- ❖ We need the Holy Spirit upon us and within us.
- ❖ Our Lord Jesus had the fullness of the Holy Spirit upon Him and within Him, which is the 7 Spirits of God.
- ❖ He had the Spirit of the Lord upon Him and within Him, this was a fulfilment of Zechariah's vision of the 7-armed candlestick.
- ❖ That is why, in Nazareth, Jesus Christ proclaimed that the Spirit of the Lord God is upon Him.

(Luk 4:18) The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Jesus Christ ministered, evangelised, healed and delivered through the power of God for the Spirit of the Lord God was upon Him.

Diversity of gifts in a high level of operation worked through Him because the fullness of the Holy Spirit was upon Him.

There was a revival in Jesus Christ's ministry in Galilee because great signs and wonders were happening.

(Luk 4:40,41) Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them. And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

As the sun was setting, sick and demonised people came, they were healed and set free for the Spirit of the Lord God was upon Him.

A vision of An Ox

I had a vision of an Indian ox.

The ox was laying in the river to be refreshed.

Then he was taken out of the river and a yoke was put upon him.

Then they put a plough onto the yoke, and they ploughed the land.

A yoke comes upon.

Power comes upon to do the work of the ministry.

(Act 1:8) But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Jesus said that His yoke is easy.

(Mat 11:30) For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Jesus does give us a yoke so we can do the ministry as power comes upon us.

Elisha had 24 oxen with yokes to plough the fields.

He sacrificed all of them so he could walk in the power of the Spirit of God.
For it is not by might, nor by power, but by the Spirit of the Lord God.

You Shall Receive Power

Jesus Christ had the move of God in His life for He knew that the Spirit of the Lord God was upon Him.

He knew the key to kingdom power, glory and breakthrough lies in the Spirit of the Lord upon you.

Many movements have only taught about the Spirit within us and therefore, we have seen little power demonstrated.

The key to the great move of God lies in the Spirit upon.

That is why Jesus Christ said that you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit shall come upon you.

They had received the Holy Spirit within when Jesus Christ rose from the dead, visited them and blew upon them.

That was their born-of-the-spirit moment.

Now they also needed the Holy Spirit upon.

(Act 1:8) But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

The disciples had to tarry in prayer and worship in Jerusalem.

They did so until power from on high came upon them.

It said that there were flames of fire upon them.

(Act 2:3) And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

It says here that each had a flame upon them.

Here you go: the flame of the Holy Spirit's power came upon them to make them ready to be witnesses and fiery preachers.

Worship, Prayer and Abiding

How do we live a spiritual life in God where the Spirit rests upon us?

Jesus said wait and pray until the Holy Spirit will come upon you.

We are called to become sensitive to the Holy Spirit and know when He comes upon us.

How to get more Spirit upon:

1. Prayer releases more of the Holy Spirit upon us.
2. Worship and praise release the move of the Holy Spirit upon our lives.
3. We must learn to abide in His presence, to dwell in His presence so the Holy Spirit will remain upon us.

(Psa 85:9) Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

We are called to become sensitive to the Holy Spirit, so we do not quench or grieve Him.
The Holy Spirit wants to have communion and fellowship with us.

(2Co 13:14) The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen.

As we learn to walk with Him like this, we know He is not only within but also upon us.
Then when we minister, we press into prayer to see the power upon us released to others.

The Spirit Upon is Power and Glory

Christ said that the Holy Spirit's power would be upon us as we press in.
The Spirit upon us is His presence upon us.
His presence upon us is His manifest presence.
His manifest presence is His power and manifest glory upon us.

(2Co 3:17,18) Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

The Spirit Upon Benny Hinn

Benny Hinn's encounter with the Holy Spirit was very powerful.
The Holy Spirit came upon him in his room after he had been to a Kathryn Kuhlmann meeting.
He said that for days, it was like electric volts went through him.
He understood the importance of the Holy Spirit upon and being sensitive to the Holy Spirit.
The Bible says that we must not grieve or quench the Holy Spirit.
This has to do with the Holy Spirit upon us in our ministry.
I have been to 7 meetings that were led by Benny and have seen him, minister, through the glory and power of the Holy Spirit.
The major key in his ministry is worship.

Ruth Ward Heflin says that we must praise until worship comes, worship until the glory comes and then stand in the glory until miracles happen.

Benny knew that the Holy Spirit must come upon the ministers and worshippers.
When the Spirit is upon or the manifest presence, which is the glory, is in the room, miracles, healings, signs and wonders will break out.

Power Evangelism

We are now called to do power evangelism.

Power evangelism works when the power of the Spirit of the Lord is upon us.

Then there is breakthrough power and boldness upon us.

I have experienced this on many occasions during street evangelism.

Once, in England, as I was playing the guitar while leading worship on the street, this power of the Holy Spirit came upon me.

I then went to different people and boldly shared Christ and they were saved.

We saw this in Ghana as I led the team while doing street evangelism as the spirit of boldness was upon us, people were healed and delivered and some saved, Hallelujah.

Glory and Power Within

The Holy Spirit wants to give us glory upon us and glory within us.
Out of the riches of God's glory, He wants to strengthen us within.

This is the work of the Spirit of might within us.

The Spirit of might, out of the riches of God's glory, wants to strengthen us with might or power in our spirit.

(Eph 3:16) That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

He wants to strengthen us in our inner man or spirit, so we can be strong against sin, temptation and sickness.

This glory comes to our inner man to heal our wounds or wounded spirit so we can arise, be counted and soar like an eagle.

Our Lord said that rivers will flow from within.

(Joh 7:38) He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

God wants 7 rivers or fullness to be upon us and within us.

Ezekiel's Vision of a River

Ezekiel's vision of a river shows us that there are levels in the river of God.

- ❖ To move in the 7 Spirits or fullness of God is a way of surrendering me, myself and I.
- ❖ It is easier to receive the anointing, which is what God gives, than the 7 Spirits of God, which is who God is.
- ❖ It is His divine life released in a greater measure in our lives.

(2Pe 1:3) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

- ❖ We become stewards of God's life, nature and character on earth which are heaven's pearls.

In Ezekiel's vision of a river, we see that the river's first depth is ankle-deep, then knee-deep, then up to loin-deep and then lastly to the swimming level.

(Eze 47:3-5) And when the man that had the line in his hand went forth eastward, he measured a thousand cubits, and he brought me through the waters; the waters were to the ankles. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters were to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters were to the loins. Afterward he measured a

thousand; and it was a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

At the end of the vision, it talks about the fisherman standing by the river to catch fish.

What the Lord is saying is that the more you surrender and learn to abide in the presence of God upon and within, the more the fullness will be in your life.

The more intensity and depth we are a part of, the more blessings that we will have and the more you will catch fish.

This is how evangelism is done through the 7 Spirits of God. Amen.

Chapter 8: Daystar's Power for Transformation and Victory

The Daystar

Jesus Christ is the Daystar.

He wants the daystar to arise in our hearts.

(2Pe 1:9) But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

Jesus Christ, who is the Daystar, has the power to transform us into His image.

We are called to live in Christ and to become like Christ.

We are called to say, It is no longer I that lives but Christ in me.

As we humble ourselves daily, we will look like Him.

(Gal 2:20) I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Me, myself, and I will die, so Christ can transform us.

Divine Power

Apostle Peter said that God has given us divine power for life and godliness.

(2Pe 1:3) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

This divine power is power for transformation.

Divine power is transformation power to grow in godliness.

Peter was a mighty man of God.

He learnt how to maintain the abiding power and glory within and upon his life.

He learnt to be changed from glory to glory.

In the height of his ministry, the glory cloud was upon him.

He was overshadowed by the shekinah glory and, therefore, the people were healed as they came near to him.

(Act 5:15,16) Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Therefore, apostle Peter was ministering in fullness.

The fullness is the 7 Spirits of God burning before God's throne and moving through our lives.

There is one Holy Spirit who comes in 7 different manifestations.

All 7 release greater realms of glory, gifts, powers and anointings.

Eyewitnesses at the Transfiguration

Apostles Peter, John and James were eyewitnesses at the transfiguration of the Lord Jesus Christ.

On the holy mountain (which was Mount Hermon) as Jesus Christ was being transfigured, they saw His majesty.

(2Pe 1:16-18) For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount.

The word used here for overshadowing in the Greek is *ApyKisor*, which means overshadowing, was also used in Acts 5:15,16 where the shekinah glory of Jesus Christ was upon Apostle Peter.

❖ Here we see the fullness upon Peter.

❖ Here He ministered from the 7 Spirits of God who release the glory cloud.

(Act 5:15,16) Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

It was the overshadowing of God's shekinah glory that did the signs, wonders and miracles.

Apostle Peter's Transformational Walk

Peter walked with the Lord as His disciple for three years.

For three years, he saw the glory of God and the fullness of the 7 Spirits of God upon Jesus Christ.

John gives testimony of this.

(Joh 1:14-16) And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me. And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

His time as a disciple gave Peter a hunger to become a vessel for the glory and fullness of God.

Therefore, Peter started to walk on the pathway of transformation.

We are called to be transformed from glory to glory.

The 7 Spirits of God are here to help us to be transformed from glory to glory.

All the 7 Spirits are holy.

It is the holy glory of the 7 Spirits of God that do the transformation within us so we can learn to walk in the fullness within and upon.

(2Co 3:18) But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

The Spirit of the Lord is the main spirit of the 7 Spirits of God.

The 7 Spirits of God transform us from glory to glory.

We are called to be transformed from a caterpillar to a pupa into a beautiful butterfly.

(Rom 12:2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

The Way of Transformation

We are called to be transformed.

Transformed into the image of Jesus Christ, this is true discipleship.

The way of transformation comes through daily repentance at the cross of Christ and the fullness or the 7 Spirits of God in our lives.

We are called to go from personal revival to transformation or reformation into a habitation, which is the abiding presence of God within us and upon us.

Many want to stay in their traditions, even the Pentecost, charismatic or glory traditions, yet resist change.

The fullness or the 7 Spirits of God call for transformation.

Habitation cannot occur without transformation.

Part of this is picking up your cross.

Without carrying your cross, you will not be transformed and live in a place of habitation.

Habitation is the 7 Spirits of God flowing from within and upon.

Zechariah's Vision

Zechariah's vision shows us 2 olive trees that use 2 pipes to send their oil to a bowl.

The bowl full of oil sends this oil, by the 7 pipes upon and within, to the 7-armed candlestick or Menorah.

(Zec 4:2) And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof:

The vision given to Zechariah shows us the spiritual reality that the 7 Spirits of God need to be within us and upon us.

Therefore, the Lord Jesus Christ said the Spirit of the Lord God was upon Him.

(Luk 4:18) The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

The Last Day move of the fullness of God, or 7 Spirits of God is the Spirit within and upon.

Let's embrace the move of the fullness which comes through the 7 Spirits of God.

The 9 Trumpet Vision and Encounter

I was in a meeting at Victoria Point, Queensland and had a great encounter about the 7 Spirits of God.

For a week after this, the Holy Spirit was teaching me as He revealed more and more of this mystery is revealed.

The Vision

I saw the 7 Spirits of God.

They were giving off light, which formed the 7 colours of the rainbow around the throne.

In front of them flowed a river of fiery lava.

This river of lava fire came out of them.

The bible says that the 7 Spirits of God are burning before the throne.

(Rev 4:5) And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Then I saw 9 trumpets being blown.

7 of the trumpets were being blown by the 7 Spirits of God.

The other 2 trumpets, which make up the 9 trumpets were blown by 2 Arch Angels.

I saw the 9 trumpets blowing before the throne of God and a voice came out of the trumpets.

We see this in Revelations 4:1, where a voice comes out of a trumpet with a message.

(Rev 4:1) After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

All 9 voices of the 9 trumpets were speaking about all of God's different attributes, like His love, joy, shalom and goodness.

There is a biblical encounter where God Himself is declaring to Moses as He reveals His glory, His attributes of love, grace, kindness, abundant goodness, etc.

The 7 trumpets are breakthrough power to release the glory and the glorious attributes.

(Exo 34:6) And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth,

In this move of the 7 Spirits of God, God wants to transform us by the transformational power of the 7 Spirits of God.

He does this by revealing to us His love, kindness, mercy, and abundant goodness more deeply.

Every one of the 7 Spirits reveals a different or deeper side of every attribute.

This takes us into deeper revelations of the heart of God.

He uses divine power to do this transformation.

God's Trumpet and Fire at Sinai

On Mount Sinai, God Himself came down in a fire.

The mountain melted like wax in the presence of the Lord.

(Exo 19:18) And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

Then God's voice came to them by a shofar or trumpet.

(Exo 19:19) And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and God answered him by a voice.

The voice of the trumpet became so loud that all the people in the camp trembled.

(Exo 19:16) And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled.

God's shofar and the voice of the shofar bring breakthrough.

- ❖ God set an example on Mount Sinai, that God's voice, through the shofar, can bring forth breakthroughs and make nations tremble as God's power manifests.
- ❖ Therefore, when Joshua's priests blew the shofars, the walls of Jericho came down.
- ❖ When Gideon's army blew the shofar, the Midianites were defeated by God's angel armies.

Breakthrough Power and the Fruits

- ❖ The 7 Spirits of God's breakthrough sound and breakthrough power want to bring forth deliverance, inner healing, and the fruits of the Holy Spirit.
- ❖ As the 7 Spirits of God's power is released upon us and in us, they want to bring forth God's attributes in our lives, e.g. Compassion, humility, gentleness, love, etc.
- ❖ We need God's divine power to grow in eternal life and godliness.

(2Pe 1:3) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

Without this power of the 7 Spirits of God working upon and within us, the process of spiritual growth slows down.

The 7 Spirits or fullness speeds up the process of spiritual growth.

His Abiding Presence

God's desire for us is that we live in His abiding presence.

The Spirit's power upon us can remain as we stay on the pathway of transformation.

Yet many have a powerful infilling of the Spirit upon and within but because of sin or sinful habits, they lose this outpouring a few days later.

Now, we will look at Peter's life, how he had to grow up so he could live in God's abiding glory and presence.

Peter's Transformation Prophesied

Andrew was a disciple of John the Baptist.

When he heard John say that Jesus was the Lamb of God, yes, the Mashiach, he started to follow Jesus.

He then called Simon and brought him to Jesus.

Jesus then spoke a prophetic word that Simon would become like a stone.

(Joh 1:42) And he brought him to Jesus. And when Jesus beheld him, he said, Thou art Simon the son of Jona: thou shalt be called Cephas, which is by interpretation, A stone.

Jesus was prophesying that Simon would go through the process of transformation and would become Peter.

Simon means a reed and Peter means a stone.

This shows that at the end of the transformation, Peter would be a stable man of God.

Peter the Believer

Peter became a believer in Jesus as Lord and Saviour.

He said, Lord, where can I go for You have the words of eternal life.

(Joh 6:68) Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.

He said this when many who had followed Jesus Christ left Him.

Therefore, Peter as a follower of Jesus Christ grew in his faith.

He was called to bring forth a hundred-fold fruit.

We are also called to grow in our faith in Christ.

Peter as a Disciple

Apostle Peter did not stay a believing Pew-sitter.

He chose to be a disciple.

Discipleship is the pathway of transformation.

Discipleship makes us grow in godly character, integrity, and the fruit of the Holy Spirit.

To be a disciple, you have to pick up the cross.

(Luk 14:27) And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

It also says that God disciplines His children He loves so that they grow in holiness.

(Heb 12:5 AMP) And you have (completely) forgotten the divine word of appeal and encouragement in which you are reasoned with and addressed as sons? My son, do not think lightly or scorn to submit to the correction and discipline of the Lord, nor lose courage and give up and faint when you are reproved or corrected by Him.

The Lord disciplined Peter the disciple as a son.

We see this in different places in the scripture, but Peter does not take offence.

Peter's Repentance

Repentance is very important on this pathway of transformation.

Peter the disciple always wanted to be first.

it worked for him, yet it was also his weak spot.

As a disciple, God was using Peter and breaking him so he could come forth as gold.

When the Lord said on the night that He was taken prisoner, that all of them would be offended at Him.

Peter's reply was no, I will not be offended.

Then Jesus replied that Peter would deny Him three times before the cock crowed two times.

(Mar 14:29,30) But Peter said unto him, Although all shall be offended, yet will not I. And Jesus saith unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this day, even in this night, before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice.

When this came to pass, Peter was shocked.

He went away and repented, was broken, and wept deeply.

Therefore, God raised him to carry the glory upon him and within him.

So much so that the shekinah glory flowed through Apostle Peter to heal the sick.

The Key of Godliness

Apostle Peter now advises us on how to maintain the move of God in and upon us.

We must let the Lord work within us.

We must go through the process of transformation.

This will open the door to be mightily used in the kingdom of God's glory and power on the earth.

He teaches us the keys of the kingdom.

Peter says that through God's divine power, we can grow in godliness.

(2Pe 1:3) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

God's plan to maintain the power and glory upon us and in us requires us to become godly saints.

This is a major key to God's kingdom – godliness.

How to Grow Up

Apostle Peter then shows us how to grow up.

He does this by showing up the pathway of how to grow

(2Pe 1:5-7) And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.

The pathway of growth is:

1. Diligence
2. Faith
3. Virtue
4. Knowledge
5. Temperance
6. Patience
7. Godliness
8. Love or kindness
9. Love to all or charity

If we grow up in these attributes, fruits and qualities, then an abundant way to the kingdom of God is opened.

This means kingdom ministry here on earth and when we die heaven will be opened for us.

All 9 qualities are keys of the kingdom.

All 9 will help to maintain the abiding glory and presence in our lives.

All 9 will help us to grow in inner transformation.

- ❖ The power of the 7 Spirits of God is here to help us grow in freedom through inner transformation by inner healing, deliverance for the inner man and to grow the fruits of the Spirit.

Through Mighty Power

How does this work?

- ❖ It says that we are to be strengthened with the might of His glorious power, in the inner man or our spirit, so we can grow in patience and longsuffering.

Therefore, it is this glorious power that will bring forth the fruit of patience and longsuffering.

(Col 1:11) Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

- ❖ Paul says that we need might (which is one of the 7 Spirits) in the inner man to be strengthened so that we break through in love.

(Eph 3:16,17) That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,

- ❖ The power of the 7 Spirits breaks the bondages in our lives where we are bound by the darkness of traumas, pain and hurt.
- ❖ The 7 Spirits of God will also bring healing and pour out the balm of Gilead on our wounds.
- ❖ This power will set us free so we can grow in the love, peace, and joy of the Lord.

Virtue

Virtue is a great, glorious flow of the holy presence of God in our lives.
It helps in our process of transformation.

God wants the daystar to arise in our hearts.

The morning star or daystar is Jesus Christ's image in you, which is Christ, the hope of glory.

(2Pe 1:19) We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

It says that our faith in Christ releases virtue in us.

The Greek word for virtue is Arete.

It means:

- a. Excellence
- b. Moral excellence
- c. Force or power of God's excellency

We understand that virtue here comes from God's holy presence for holy also means moral purity. Peter's use of the word virtue here is where virtue is enjoyed as an essential quality in the exercise of faith

This virtue will enable us to grow in patience, temperance, love, the intimate knowledge of the Lord and godliness.

Virtue for Spiritual and Moral Growth

- ❖ The virtue released by our faith releases power for growth into the divine nature of God.
- ❖ Virtue's power helps us grow in the fruit of the Spirit.
- ❖ Virtue's power helps us to grow in godliness.
- ❖ Virtue, which is moral excellence, comes forth out of God's holy presence.
- ❖ Holy means sacred, complete and moral purity.

- ❖ As God's holy presence is morally pure, its virtue can bring forth godliness.

(Psa 99:5) Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; for he is holy.

To be used mightily by the 7 Spirits of God, we need to grow in godliness.

Ungodliness disqualifies us from a great move of the 7 Spirits upon our lives.

Therefore, we need to repent of our ungodly ways, habits, and sins and put on Christ where we still move in the flesh.

Going Deeper

To go higher and to abide in that place of the 7 Spirits before the throne, we have to go deeper and lower still.

Through faith, we can go higher as Revelations 4:1 calls us to.

To abide in that place we have to go deeper and lower.

Virtue helps us to go deeper and lower!

Virtue helps us to see where we need to repent and let the cross of Christ work in us.

If we want to come up higher, we also must go deeper and lower.

- ❖ No crown without the cross.
- ❖ No mountain without a valley.
- ❖ The fruits grow in the valley.
- ❖ Therefore, we are to grow spiritual fruit on the inside.

(Psa 45:13) The king's daughter is all glorious within: her clothing is of wrought gold.

- ❖ The king's daughter is all glorious within.
- ❖ It is all about the glory within.
- ❖ The bride of Christ is also called to grow the glory within.
- ❖ If the inner man is not formed after the image of Christ, the outside glory will fade away.

The glory within

- We have an inner mantle or anointing
- We have an outer mantle or anointing

King David understood this principle.

He took off his kingly mantle and danced with his inner mantle, which was a priestly garment, before the Ark.

He humbled himself.

The cost was the despising of his wife Michal.

Glory, Virtue and Power

Virtue based in faith also released God's force, authority or power.

We see this with the woman with the issue of blood.

Her faith in Christ was strong.

She touched the outside mantle of Jesus Christ as she was being healed, for there was healing virtue flowing through it from Christ Himself.

In one Bible translation, it says that power had gone out of Christ.

(Mar 5:30 ASV) And straightway Jesus, perceiving in himself that the power proceeding from Him had gone forth, turned him about in the crowd, and said, Who touched my garments?

We are called to glory and virtue.

(2Pe 1:3) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

Glory releases virtue, power, and anointing.

The Daystar

God is calling us to let the Daystar arise in our hearts.

When Christ is formed in us, the fruit of the Spirit has grown in us.

This gives us discernment about true teachers, prophets, and apostles.

Peter warns about the false. In 2 Peter 2 and 3, yet, build the true foundation of Christ in us in 2 Peter 1.

In the Last Day, God is going to raise the believers who know God deeply and intimately.

(Dan 11:32) And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.

They have been living on the pathway of transformation and, therefore, the Daystar is shining through them.

They are going to be godly saints who will lead many to righteousness in Christ.

They will shine as righteous stars forever and ever.

(Dan 12:3) And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

Chapter 9: Mantle of Fire

Prophet Elijah – A Prophet of Fire

Elijah was a prophet who preached repentance and had a spiritual mantle of fire!

When we follow the ministry of Prophet Elijah, we see that he is often called upon to release God's judgement fire.

Therefore, Prophet Elijah is known as a prophet of fire.

In the days of great darkness when King Ahab and Queen Jezebel reigned, they brought moral decay, and idolatry, Elijah had a great zeal to serve Yahweh.

In the first place, his battle was not with people, but with satanic principalities, wicked powers, and evil forces in high places.

These spirits led the nation of Israel away and deceived them to go back and serve a satanic Phoenician Canaanite religion which worshipped the sun god Baal.

Joshua had been used to free the nation of this evil religion.

In that time, it still existed in Phoenicia, which is the land of the Philistines and, today is called Lebanon.

Calling Down Fire

King Ahaziah, Ahab and Jezebel's son, in Israel's northern territory looked to the sun god Baal for answers.

King Ahaziah had fallen and was wounded; he then sent his servants to go to the sun god's idols in Ekron, which was in the Philistine nation.

He was sent there to ask Baalzebub if he would be healed.

(2Ki 1:2) And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that was in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, enquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease.

The devil had misled this king to worship the sun god just as his father Ahab and his mother Jezebel had done.

Yahweh, the God of Israel was not happy and sent Elijah with a word of rebuke and judgment to the king's servants.

(2Ki 1:3,4) But the angel of the LORD said to Elijah the Tishbite, Arise, go up to meet the messengers of the king of Samaria, and say unto them, Is it not because there is not a God in Israel, that ye go to enquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron? Now therefore thus saith the LORD, Thou shalt not come down from that bed on which thou art gone up, but shalt surely die. And Elijah departed.

Therefore, the battle was between the God of Israel and the evil spirit realm of the sun god.

It was between true worship and false worship.

The name of the God of Israel was at stake.

King Ahaziah was angered at Elijah's response and sent a captain with 50 soldiers to capture God's prophet.

Prophet Elijah understood that it was a spiritual battle.

It was about true and false worship.

Therefore, he said, if I am a man of God let the fire come down and consume these men.

Fire came down and consumed them.

(2Ki 1:9,10) Then the king sent unto him a captain of fifty with his fifty. And he went up to him: and, behold, he sat on the top of an hill. And he spake unto him, Thou man of God, the king hath said, Come down. And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I be a man of God, then let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

This happened 2 times.

The third captain who came understood what had happened and humbly asked the prophet to save his life from Yahweh's judgement fire.

In reverence of the God of Israel called Yahweh and the prophet of God, he led him to the king.

Prophet Elijah gave the king God's message that King Ahaziah would die.

- ❖ This story was a preparation for the End Time.
- ❖ Elijah is coming back, and fire will be called down.
- ❖ It will make the way for many to come to Christ.
- ❖ For in that day, people must serve either Christ or the antichrist.
- ❖ For it is about heaven or hell

John the Baptist Preaches Repentance

John the Baptist came in the spirit of Elijah.

He was the forerunner of Christ.

He called the people to repentance and preached about the kingdom of God.

(Mat 3:11) I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

John the Baptist walked in repentance fire and said that Christ would baptise us with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Christ Preached Repentance

Our Lord Jesus Christ preached repentance, faith and the kingdom of God.

(Mat 4:17) From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

The Messiah walked and ministered in glory, fullness, and holy fire.

Our Lord and Saviour came to save and redeem us from sin, idolatry, darkness, and the devil.

He opened the way to restore fellowship with God the Father, gives us eternal life and opens the way to heaven for us.

Jesus Christ Preached about Hell

Our Lord Jesus Christ came to redeem us and warned us about sin and hell.
Christ warned us about the work of the devil, sin, and darkness that leads us to hell.
He said that there is a great judgement day coming.

(Mat 25:41) Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Elijah and John the Baptist were forerunners of these messages, yet Jesus Christ's warnings about hell and judgement were more numerous.

True Fruits

Jesus said that by their fruit, you shall know them.

(Mat 7:16) Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?
(Mat 7:17) Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.
(Mat 7:20) Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

A true ministry is known by its fruits, not by its power.

The Daystar, Jesus Christ, has to arise in our hearts.

Christ's character, lifestyle, and fruits of the Spirit must be seen in your life, for out of this shines the glory.

The glory shines from within outwards.

The Battle between our Spirit and Flesh

We are called to war with our spirit, in the Holy Spirit, against sin that can kill our spiritual life.

By grace, we are saved, and in Christ, there is no condemnation.

Therefore, we are called to fight sin by God's gracious power.

We are called to become overcomers over our sins.

If we live in the sins of fornication, adultery, idolatry, or drunkenness, we will not inherit the kingdom.

(Gal 5:16-21) This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

As we walk in the Spirit of life in Christ we are called to walk on the narrow road of life that leads to the gate of life.

(Mat 7:13,14 NLT) You can enter God's kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide for many who choose that way. But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it.

Wilful Sins Keeps us out of Heaven

John the Baptist and Jesus preached about repentance and the kingdom of God. John the Baptist said that they must bring forth the fruit of repentance.

(Mat 3:8) Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

Apostle Paul warned us that if we go back to live or stay in sin, the kingdom of God will be closed for us.

(1Co 6:9,10) Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

This is a serious message that Apostle Paul gives and you can find it in three different scripture references.

(Eph 5:3-5) But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks. For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

7 Spirits of God are Burning

The Bible says that the 7 Spirits of God which is the fullness, are burning before the throne.

The 7 Spirits of God are 7 flames and 7 fires.

(Rev 4:5) And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

God is one God and out of Him comes the fullness or the manifestation of the 7 flames of God which are the 7 Spirits of God.

Our God is a consuming fire; therefore, the 7 Spirits of God can also manifest as the 7 consuming fires.

In the Last Days, we will see this happen in meetings in a greater way.

Demons will scream and leave quickly as deliverance will happen.

As demons of sickness leave, great healings will take place.

Many will repent as the Spirit of the Lord's conviction fire will fall.

(Heb 12:29) For our God is a consuming fire.

The 7 Spirits are a Consuming Fire for God is Holy!

In this chapter, we will look at the working and function of the 7 Spirits of God in the Last Days.

Last Days evangelism will be different from what we have been used to.

The 7 Spirits of God will make us much bolder, on-fire and supernatural in our manner of evangelism.

In these Last Days, there will be great confrontations.

We see this in the scripture about the 2 witnesses who will call down fire.

(Rev 11:3) And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

(Rev 11:5) And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

Many will come to Christ as we learn to move in that boldness, baptisms of fire, and the manifestation of great signs, wonders and miracles.

God Came Down with Fire on Mount Sinai

Before Israel was going into the promised land, God revealed to them who He was and gave them commandments to follow.

He manifested Himself as a consuming fire.

For the Lord descended upon Mount Sinai in a fire!

(Exo 19:18) And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

God was in the Fire

Here on Mount Sinai as God come down in a fire, we see that our God is a consuming fire.

- ❖ The smoke from the fire ascended as the smoke of a furnace
- ❖ The whole mountain quaked greatly
- ❖ There were thunders and flashes of lightning
- ❖ A thick cloud had come upon Mount Sinai for the Lord had descended on it in fire

The vision of the 9 Trumpets

In chapter 8 we talked about the vision of the 9 trumpets.

I saw the 7 Spirits of God and 2 Archangels blowing trumpets.

In the account of God coming down in a fire on Mount Sinai, we see the truth of the power of the trumpet or shofar.

God is the author of it all.

The Trumpet

As God came down, there was the sound of a trumpet.

The sound of the trumpet became louder and louder.

It became exceedingly loud.

So loud that the people in the camp trembled.

(Exo 19:16) And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled.

Moses said that the Lord had come to prove them so that they would fear Him and not sin.

(Exo 20:20) And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not.

God wanted His people to become a holy nation, a royal priesthood.

God came down in fire, awe, majesty and power while the sound of the trumpet became louder and louder to show them that He is holy and victorious so that no one was able to stand before Him.

Possessing Canaan and Pulling Down its Sun Worship Idolatry

In the days of Noah, there were giants in the land.

(Gen 6:4) There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

Today, around the world you can find ancient sun worship temples which go back to the days of the giants in Noah's day. One of them can be found in Machu Picchu, Peru.

The biggest pyramid in Egypt (and others as well) is where this sun worship occurred in Noah's day.

The religion of the Phoenicians and its Canaanite family built their sun worship religion, which they called Baal worship, upon the religion of the giants from the days of Noah.

Among the Phoenicians and their families were many giants.

Goliath, who was killed by King David, was one of them, along with his 5 brothers from the land of the Philistines.

This story means we cannot deny that the scripture that there were giants in those days.

Jesus said that in the Last Days, it would be as in the days of Noah.

In Noah's day, there was sun worship and there were giants.

Today, Baal statues are set up in western nations and there are rumours of giants.

(Luk 17:26,27) And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.

The Sound of the Shofar Brings Victory

- ❖ Yahweh, the God of Israel, had come on Mount Sinai in fire and lightning, shaking the earth with the sound of the shofar or trumpet.
- ❖ By manifesting His presence in the way of fire, earthquake, lightning, and the shofar, God showed the ways He would bring victory for the nation of Israel.
- ❖ To take the wall of Jericho, they were called to walk around it for 7 days and on the seventh day to blow the shofars.

(Jos 6:20) So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

This blowing of the shofar was the sound of Yahweh who came down on Mount Sinai with the sound of the shofar and gave them the victory.

They then burnt the city with fire, for our God is a holy consuming fire and they obeyed His command to do so.

(Jos 6:24) And they burnt the city with fire, and all that was therein: only the silver, and the gold, and the vessels of brass and of iron, they put into the treasury of the house of the LORD.

Today, God is raising up shofar blowers, so God can use the sound of the shofar used in faith to bring victory.

Activation of the Vision of the 7 Trumpets

Today, in God's army, we are being raised up to live, walk, and minister in the spirit. The Holy Spirit wants to sound heavens trumpets through us by worship and intercession.

(Rom 8:26) Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

It is to break down the walls of Jericho in this world and our lives. The 7 Spirits of God want to sound these sounds of breakthrough through us. We can do this in worship, prayer, or blowing shofars.

Release of Signs and Miracles by the 9 Trumpets

The sound of the Spirit of God through us wants to release breakthroughs of signs, wonders, and miracles with the 7 Spirits of God.

The Holy Spirit will release His fire as on Elijah when we move. Conviction fire will fall and sinners will be saved.

The 7 Spirits of God are Holy and Release Holy Fire

As we surrender more to the working of the 7 Spirits of God, a greater fire will be released in our life.

This will result in greater power in evangelism and breakthroughs.

More lasting fruit will come because people will truly repent and be broken at the cross of Christ.

King Ethbaal's (father of Jezebel) Evils

Prophet Elijah was to show Israel the way back to the true God of Israel.

He had to deal with major forces of darkness released against the nation of Israel.

These forces were especially unleashed by King Ethbaal of Tyre, Phoenicia or Zidon.

He was the father of Jezebel who married King Ahab to become queen.

(1Ki 16:31) And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him.

King Ethbaal was a Baal or sun god worshipper living in Zidon which was a part of Phoenicia.

The Phoenicians religion was the Canaanite religion.

V

The Phoenician people were dispersed remnants of the old Canaan giants, which Joshua had conquered.

Phoenicia, which is Lebanon today, was one of the places the giants escaped to.

They worshipped the sun god called Baal and the king Ethbaal (Ithbaal in Wikipedia) was even connected to the god by his name.

Jezebel means 'where is my prince?', referring to prince Baal.

King Ethbaal made his kingdom evil and great.

He took the whole area of Phoenicia and called it Tyre, he then took the Island of Cyprus, parts of Libya and some other coastal areas.

In Tangier, there is a stela (a monument) with the inscription "We are they who fled from Joshua, the robber, the son of Nun."

This shows that the giants migrated to many areas from Canaan.

They sacrificed thousands of children to their god Molech, the god of fire, as an offer to worship Baal.

They used this evil power of child sacrifice to give them the power to conquer all these nations.

This is the Phoenician Canaanite dark evil religion.

Hiram of Abiff was a Phoenician, much of Freemasonry is built upon his name.

Freemasonry is built upon this evil dark satanic religion of the Phoenician or Canaanite nation.

This has its roots in Ancient Babylon.

On this foundation, the one-world government and religion have their roots.

Later, Ezekiel prophesied against this satanic stronghold on the Island of Tyre, just off the coast of the city of Tyre, today's Lebanon.

Tyre is the place of the legend of the birth of Europe.

It is therefore the root of the number 666.

Alexander the Great fought one of his biggest, bloodiest battles there as he joined the Island of Tyre with the city of Tyre.

Jezebel's father, King Ethbaal had laid the foundation for this evil place.

(Eze 28:2) Son of man, say unto the prince of Tyrus, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thine heart is lifted up, and thou hast said, I am a God, I sit in the seat of God, in the midst of the seas; yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God:

God Answers with Fire!

Yahweh, the God of Israel, was angry about the false sun-god worship of Baal.

So, He sent the Prophet Elijah to King Ahab to prophesy that there would be no rain.

(1Ki 17:1) And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

Elijah went to a brook to live while there was no rain, after the brook dried up, God sent Elijah to Zarephath.

God sent Elijah there to make him spiritually strong for Zarapheth was in Zidon or Tyre where King Ethbaal reigned.

When the right time came, three years from the start of the drought, Elijah was sent back to see King Ahab to set up a contest to demonstrate who the true God was and is.

When the contest came, Yahweh, the God of Israel, sent a lightning strike and consumed the burnt sacrifices.

(1Ki 18:38-40) Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, he is the God; the LORD, he is the God. And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.

When the people saw it, they fell on their faces and said, 'Yahweh is the God of Israel'.

Then they killed all the false prophets.

Elijah was a revivalist, yet the nation needed reformation.

The nations received revival, yet it needed reformation from the top down.

The king believed yet did not repent and turn from his evil ways.

Queen Jezebel was not moved from her evil and wanted to kill Prophet Elijah.

Elijah and a Mantle of Fire

Under the Spirit of might, Elijah was a man of fire.

His mantle or ministry was a ministry of fire.

After the great victory at Mount Carmel, where God's fire came down and the Baal prophets were killed, Satan attacked Elijah.

The forces of darkness though King Ethbaal of Phoenicia and Queen Jezebel came to him with a death threat.

Jezebel said that she would kill Elijah for what he had done.

(1Ki 19:2) Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying, So let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not thy life as the life of one of them by to morrow about this time.

Elijah did not yet realise how much power of God was on him, so God allowed him to run to Mount Sinai.

Mount Sinai was the mountain where, in Moses' day, God came down in fire for all the people to see.

(Exo 19:18) And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

He wanted to experience the same things Moses saw, yet God taught him to trust in God's still small voice.

God then sent him back to face the situation in Israel for the mantle of fire was upon Elijah.

No one could kill Elijah without God's permission for the mantle of fire was upon Elijah.

We see this mantle of fire of protection at work when Jezebel's son is angry at him.

Elijah's Consuming Mantle of Fire

King Ahaziah was angry with Elijah for chastising him about his false reliance on Baalzebub.

❖ He was the son of Jezebel, and the old spirit of Queen Jezebel arose in him.

❖ King Ahaziah, under Baal's power, wanted the death of Elijah so that the voice of Yahweh, the God of Israel, would be silenced.

Therefore, he sent a captain with 50 soldiers to capture Elijah, which was the wrong thing to do, for he was the prophet of fire.

(2Ki 1:9) Then the king sent unto him a captain of fifty with his fifty. And he went up to him: and, behold, he sat on the top of an hill. And he spake unto him, Thou man of God, the king hath said, Come down.

Elijah knew God's still small voice and said, if I am a man of God as the man said, let fire come down and consume all of them.

Fire came down and consumed the captain and the fifty soldiers.

(2Ki 1:10) And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I be a man of God, then let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

❖ This shows that Elijah never needed to flee from Jezebel in the first place.

The consuming fire mantle was upon his life.

There was victory and they became terrified of this consuming fire.

Elijah himself gave the word to the king and the king died according to God's word.

(2Ki 1:15-17) And the angel of the LORD said unto Elijah, Go down with him: be not afraid of him. And he arose, and went down with him unto the king. And he said unto him, Thus saith the LORD,

Forasmuch as thou hast sent messengers to enquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron, is it not because there is no God in Israel to enquire of his word? therefore thou shalt not come down off that bed on which thou art gone up, but shalt surely die. So he died according to the word of the LORD which Elijah had spoken. And Jehoram reigned in his stead in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah; because he had no son.

By God consuming 50 soldiers twice and the death of King Ahaziah, Israel knew that Yahweh was Israel's God.

God was going to raise up Jehu to wipe out Jezebel.

Holy Holy Holy and the 7 Spirits of God

Our God is holy.

We are to worship our Lord God before His throne with a pure heart, for our God is holy.

(Psa 99:5) Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; for he is holy.

Our God is holy, and the angels worship our God as they say holy, holy, holy is the Lord our God.

(Isa 6:3) And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

The 7 Spirits of God are burning with holy fire as they are the manifestation of our holy God.

All through the Old Testament, we see the 7 Spirits of God functioning.

Many times, the main spirit of the 7, the Spirit of the Lord, is called into action as we see Him on King David, Elijah, or Elisha, etc.

(1Sa 16:13) Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

- ❖ We see the great power and fire of the 7 Spirits through the Spirit of might as it consumed the temple sacrifices at Solomon's dedication of the temple, or by Elijah as fire consumed the sacrifices or God came down in a fire on Mount Sinai.

In the last 7 years, these acts of fire and power will also be happening in and through the body of Christ.

Our God is holy; therefore, it will be a holy fire.

River of Consuming Fire

In the Last Days, God's consuming fire is going to flow through the 7 Spirits as a river of fire.

God's throne will be on fire and the consuming river will flow through the 7 Spirits and bring judgment.

(Dan 7:9,10) I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands

ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

This consuming fire will flow to the earth and bring judgment to the antichrist.
It will also bring judgment to the evil empires of the beast's kingdoms and ancient kingdoms of Greece, Persia, and Babylonia.

(Dan 7:11,12) I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld even till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame. As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time.

The 7 Spirits of God in the Last Days

The spirit of Elijah is now being poured out.

Revival drops are starting to fall for the Last Day revival.

Elijah is coming back as one of the two witnesses.

The moving of the 7 Spirits of God is going to higher levels.

The former rain and the latter rain are going to be poured out at the same time.

(Joe 2:23) Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.

This means we are going to see the Old Testament miracles and the New Testament move of God go together.

Elijah together with the other witness is going to move through the fullness of God. Yes, the full measure of the 7 Spirits of God.

In the book of Revelations, it says that they are the 2 olive trees and the 2 candlesticks or Menorah of the Lord.

(Rev 11:4) These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.

This means that the 2 witnesses have the Holy Spirit upon them and within them.

That they believe in Jesus Christ as the Messiah, who is the Anointed One, and in the work of the Holy Spirit.

Then the candlestick means that they move through the power of the 7 Spirits of God.

Mighty Moves of God

In these Last Days, there are mighty revival moves of God.

In Africa, Asia, South America, and China these revivals are growing in strength.

As it gets darker, the revivals will also start in the Western nations.

The 2 witnesses will move with the 7 Spirits of God.

(Rev 11:4) These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.

The true body of Christ will also move in the anointing the 2 witnesses will move in. Therefore, great signs and wonders will happen around the world by the body of Christ, through the 7 Spirits of God.

Fire from Heaven

Elijah will be back on the scene in Israel.
He will again call fire down from heaven.

(Rev 11:5) And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

This is a sign that in the days of persecution, the believers will also have great authority. Many believers who have deeply surrendered their lives to Christ and learnt to live and minister out of the fullness will also do these greater signs, wonders, and miracles in Christ.

Great Harvest

These days before the last 7 years, many souls will come to Christ.

More believers are pressing in for the fullness, which is the ministry of the 7 Spirits of God.

This is going to keep increasing and greater signs, wonders, and miracles will happen which will result in a greater harvest.

The Bible also shows that there is going to be a great harvest in the last 7 years.

It says that a great multitude, which no one can number, will stand before the Lamb.

(Rev 7:9) After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

This multitude was saved and redeemed during the great tribulation.

(Rev 7:14) And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

They have washed their robes in the blood of the Lamb while in the tribulation.

God is going to lift Jesus Christ up in the tribulation so that great signs and wonder will happen and a multitude will be saved too numerous to count.

They will be from every nation, tribe, and tongue. Amen.
